Dear Mr. Schwencer:

The purpose of this letter is to request a change to License Condition 2 (c) (13). This License Condition should be revised as Follows:

(13) Nearby Facilities (Section 2.2.2, SSER #3)

(a) By December 31, 1982, PP&L will:

1. ensure that PG&W installs 3" equivalent cores in flow regulators C and E and either installs 2" equivalent cores or replaces flow regulators B and D with 2" regulators, and
2. have an agreement in place that will ensure that PG&W must inform PP&L of any change to their system configuration that could affect the safe operation of Susquehanna SES prior to implementation of the change, such that a configuration acceptable to PP&L will be achieved.

(b) By February 28, 1983, if the above commitments are not fulfilled, PP&L shall submit a report for NRC review and approval that describes relocation of the pipeline to a distance where unrestricted flow in the pipeline would not be hazardous to the safe operation of Susquehanna SES.

(c) By September 30, 1984, the relocation of the pipeline shall be completed if the commitments of part (a) are not fulfilled.

Justification for this change has been provided in letters, PLA-1284 dated September 9, 1982 and PLA-1300 dated September 16, 1982.

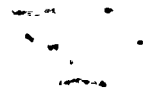


