Wilkes-Barre, Pa. January 27, 1983

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre:

WHEREAS, there was a recent incident at the Pennsylvania Power and Light Company's Susquehanna Steam Electric Station in Salem Township, Pennsylvania that could have developed into a potentially hazardous situation for area residents; and

WHEREAS, this incident involved the leakage of radioactive water at the plant.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre hereby requests and urges the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and other appropriate Federal and State Agencies to re-examine the safety measures and guidelines relative to Nuclear Power Plant design and operation and to formulate more stringent guidelines and measures to assure that incidents of such nature do not happen.
