Dear Mr. Schwencer:

As part of PP&L's effort to upgrade the Susquehanna SES Unit 1 Technical Specifications for consistency with the as-issued SSES Unit 2 Specifications (see referenced letter), attached are marked up pages reflecting changes of an administrative nature (an affected pages listing is included for cross reference).

The proposed changes, previously approved on Unit 2 (License No. NPF-22), have no impact on the safety analyses that form the basis for the Technical Specifications; they instead fall into one of the following categories:

- o Typographical corrections.
- o Addition of information to preclude the need for interpretation (e.g., exemptions to the provisions of Specification 4.0.4, new ACTION statements for existing LCO's).
- o Editorial changes (for clearer wording or presentation of information) that do not change technical requirements; including in some cases deletion of extraneous information.
- o Administrative changes made at the request of the NRC staff consistent with their objectives in the Standard Technical Specifications.
- o Changes to the Bases section to aid interpretation and provide background information on certain changes. These changes are

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administrative in nature, because, in accordance with 10CFR50.36, they are not part of the Technical Specifications.

- o Changes to figures either for clarity, or in one case, to show a change made to the PP&L property line.
- o Changes to the Administrative Controls section for consistency with Unit 2 and for two unit operation.

Based on the discussion above, the attached changes are each examples of "A purely administrative change to technical specifications per column 3, paragraph (i) of 48FR14870 and therefore do not involve significant hazards considerations.
