SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MAY 10, 2017, PUBLIC MEETING ON THE
DRAFT REGULATORY BASIS FOR THE RULEMAKING FOR
EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS FOR SMALL MODULAR
REACTORS AND OTHER NEW TECHNOLOGIES

On May 10, 2017, a Category 3 public meeting was held at the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Headquarters, Two White Flint North Auditorium, 11545 Rockville Pike, Maryland, 20852, to discuss the Draft Regulatory Basis document for the rulemaking for Emergency Preparedness (EP) for Small Modular Reactors (SMRs) and Other New Technologies (ONTs). The meeting provided an opportunity for the public and interested stakeholders to ask clarifying questions on the document. NRC staff encouraged participants to submit written comments by any one of the methods identified in the Federal Register notice (82 FR 17768). No classified, proprietary, or protected information was discussed.

Overall, the feedback from participants was in support of the staff's conclusion to proceed with rulemaking in this area. Questions and comments were generally related to potential site specific criteria that the NRC would need to review in its analysis of an Early Site Permit and/or Combined Operating Licensing application. Questions concerning issues related to co-location of SMRs/ONTs with other industrial facilities, existing nuclear power plant sites or federally owned property or sites were raised by potential applicants or their representatives. Clarifying questions related to NRC's risk-informed approach, dose consequence criteria, and cost justification for this rulemaking were also raised.

The meeting was well attended with 34 participants attending in person and 27 participating via-teleconference. Participants included NRC staff, members of the public and interested stakeholders. A list of participants is enclosed.
