The NRC staff is transmitting herewith its subject safety evaluation with its attachment, EG&G Idaho, Inc., Technical Evaluation Report (TER) dated October 1984. We find the instrumentation provided by PP&L for meeting the recommendations of Regulatory Guide 1.97 acceptable.
