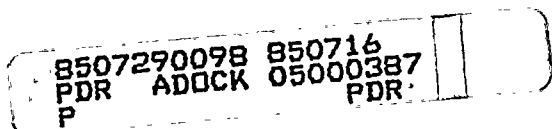

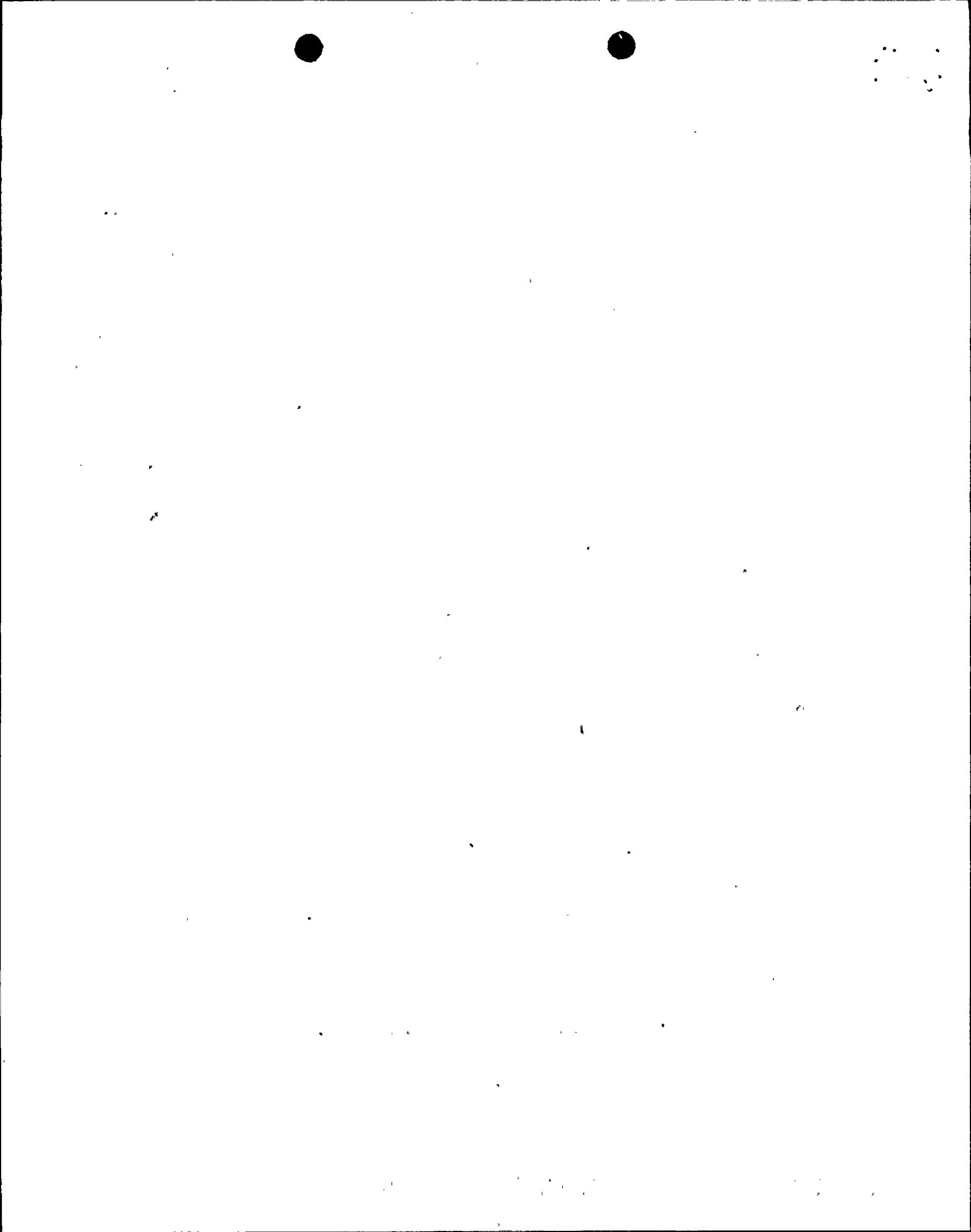

Nothing in this permit shall be construed to supercede, amend or authorize violation of the provisions of any valid and applicable local law, ordinance or regulation, provided that said local law, ordinance or regulation is not preempted by the Pennsylvania Solid Waste Management Act, the Act of July 7, 1980, Act 97, 35 P.S. 6018.101, et seq.
3. The permittee shall provide statistics of the waste tonnage received and the remaining site capacity in tons on a monthly and annual basis utilizing the Processing/Disposal Facility Daily Log and Annual Landfill Operations Report respectively.
4. Site construction and/or preparation in accordance with the application must be certified by a Registered Professional Engineer on a form provided by the Department.
5. The permittee shall designate a qualified person to be responsible for the day-to-day operation of the landfill. This person shall have daily responsibility and shall supervise the operation of the facility, including, but not limited to, accepting and documenting quantities of waste delivered to the landfill, preparation and construction of the landfill area, and disposal of wastes at the landfill. The permittee shall immediately provide the Department with written notice of any change in the employment status of such person. The permittee shall further designate such persons who shall be responsible for receiving and acting upon inquiries from the Department regarding the operation of the landfill, and the permittee shall designate such person or persons who can be contacted in the event of an emergency situation affecting the facility, after normal business hours. This information should be submitted to the Department within ten (10) days of receipt of this permit.

6. Dust resulting from the operation must be controlled.
7. Variances. This facility has not been granted any variances.
8. Completed areas and final slopes are to be graded and revegetated with an approved seeding mixture as soon as weather permits.
9. The site is to be maintained for as long as necessary after completion of the operations to prevent health or pollution hazards or nuisances from occurring. Maintenance shall include, but not be limited to, repair of cracks, fissures, slumps, and slides, repair of erosion areas, treatment of wastewater in runoff, reseeding and soil treatment until adequate permit vegetation is established.
10. The horizontal grid control system shall be controlled and tied to a permanent physical marker or object located on site. The vertical control shall be tied to an elevation established for the permanent marker. The permanent marker must be established prior to the construction.
