Dear Mr. Johnson:

It has come to our attention that the possession limit listed on your license for the 10 CFR 35.300 uses was not correct in Amendment No. 116. A corrected copy of NRC License No. 21-01430-01 is enclosed. We apologize for any inconvenience this oversight may have caused you.

In addition, we have reviewed the training documentation provided in letter dated March 30, 2017. Based on the documentation provided, we have concluded that adequate training has been provided to the Radiation Safety Officer for yttrium-90 uses permitted by 10 CFR 35.1000.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. 
