Dear Mr. Clark:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 33 to your NRC Material License No. 13-09274-03 in accordance with your February 13, 2017 letter requesting to remove 440 Scott Rolen Drive, Jasper, Indiana. In addition, the request in your February 16, 2017 (ML17061A703) letter was included in this amendment.

In your February 13, 2017 letter (ML17053A836) you confirmed that all residual licensed material located previously at 440 Scott Rolen Drive, Jasper, Indiana area of use had been removed – such that any remaining residual radioactivity in that area of use is within the limits of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 20, Subpart E, and is ALARA.

Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the 440 Scott Rolen Drive, Jasper, Indiana area of use referenced in your letter, and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities in that area of use does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material in the 440 Scott Rolen Drive, Jasper, Indiana location of use referenced in your letter are required. The 440 Scott Rolen Drive, Jasper, Indiana address authorized previously on your license is suitable for unrestricted use.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we may provide appropriate corrections and answers.


