Dear Mr. Koval:

The Pennsylvania Power & Light Company wishes to confirm the meeting set for 10:00 AM on December 9, 1986 at your office to discuss proposed methods for the cleanup of the Emergency Spray Pond at the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station (Susquehanna SES).

The Spray Pond at the Susquehanna SES is used for cooling the Emergency Service Water and the Residual Heat Removal Systems. During emergencies, water from the Spray Pond is used for safe shutdown of the plant.

Silt and sediment has been accumulating at the bottom of the pond reaching a depth soon to warrant a safety concern. Several methods of disposal of this silt and sediment have been reviewed along with their environmental impacts. Spring of 1987 is the target date for starting cleanup of the pond.
