Dear Mr. Martin:

In response to your letter dated June 22, 1987, Commonwealth Telephone Company's estimate to install four pair of permanent, dedicated telephone lines in the EOF is \$640.00 (\$160.00 per pair). This cost would be billed to the NRC on a time and material basis.

Commonwealth Telephone Company will perform the work under contract to the NRC. Mr. Chuck Clothier, (717) 283-4724, should be contacted directly to perform the work in accordance with your requirements.

Secondly, PP&L authorizes the NRC permission to: 1) use the area behind the SSES EOF building for base station equipment and, 2) collocate radio repeater equipment at our radio transmission sites on Nescopeck Mountain and North Tank. It is understood this equipment will be installed only in the event of an actual emergency or NRC participation drill and will be removed immediately at the termination of the emergency or drill. Installation, operation and removal of equipment shall be the sole responsibility of the NRC.
