SUBJECT: Interim Findings for Off-Site Preparedness in Support of
 the Susquehanna Nuclear Power Facility in Pennsylvania

This responds to the schedule in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) joint monthly report to Congress which commits us to the subject finding.

Off-site plans for the Susquehanna facility have been provided by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for review by the Regional Assistance Committee (RAC) for Luzerne and Columbia Counties. The State plan has not been submitted as scheduled; our best estimate of the date of delivery is now November 15th. Pennsylvania has developed a State plan site specific for Three Mile Island (TMI). We anticipate that the site specific plan for the Susquehanna facility will follow the same general design and organization. This situation has been discussed with Mr. Schwartz of your office.

In summary, there is no State level radiological plan site specific for the Susquehanna facility that would support an interim finding at this time. The Chairman of the RAC anticipates that his Committee will complete review of the State and local plans by December 15, 1981. As you know, the FEMA Regional testimony before the Atomic Safety Licensing Board (ASLB) on off-site emergency preparedness regarding the Susquehanna facility was concluded on October 22, 1981. If the opinion rendered by the ASLB indicates a need for additional FEMA input and NRC feels that an interim finding is necessary at that time, FEMA could provide an interim finding encompassing both State and local plans by December 22, 1981.
