This responds to your March 24, letter transmitting the revised biological assessment for the St. Lucie Plant Unit 2, Operating License Review Stage, as required by Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973 (ESA).

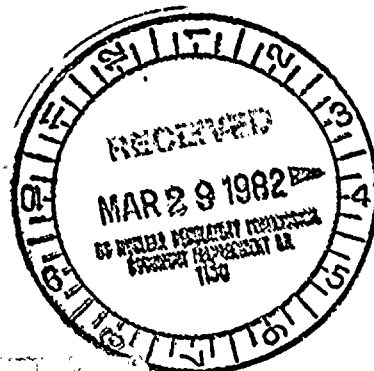
We have reviewed the biological assessment, the monitoring program, and the changes to the existing programs. Based on implementation of the monitoring programs detailed in the biological assessment, we concur with you that endangered and/or threatened species under our purview would not likely be affected.

This concludes consultation responsibilities under Section 7 of the ESA. However, consultation should be reinitiated if new information reveals impacts of the identified activity that may affect listed species or their critical habitat, a new species is listed, the identified activity is subsequently modified or critical habitat determined that may be affected by the proposed activity.
