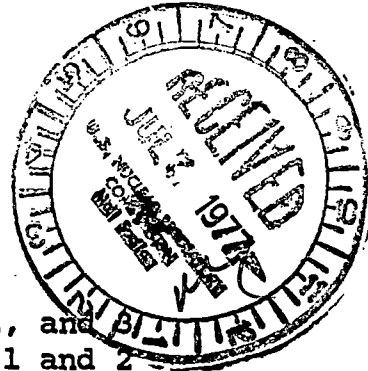

- b. If the Operator or Senior Operator demonstrates that he can operate the plant safely in the oral examination, he may be permitted to continue to perform license duties while participating in the accelerated requalification program.
  - c. If the Operator or Senior Operator fails to demonstrate that he can operate the plant safely during the oral examination, he shall be relieved of license duties until he has completed the accelerated requalification program and passed the reexamination.
- B. If a licensed individual prepares and grades the annual examination, he or she need not take the examination. This exclusion shall extend to only three individuals at each station. These three individuals shall participate in all other phases of the operator requalification program.
- C. Periodic quizzes shall be administered at the end of a lecture or series of lectures on the subjects listed in Section I, G - G. If an individual whose attendance at the lectures is mandatory receives a grade of less than 80% on these quizzes, then additional training shall be administered.
- D. An oral examination shall be administered at least once during each two year license interval to all licensed operators. This examination may consist of an oral review to determine the operator's knowledge of normal and emergency procedures and equipment or an oral review of an operator's performance conducted after a reactor startup, shutdown, or emergency. The oral examination shall be administered by a licensed member of the training staff or other licensed supervisor.
- E. Evaluations shall be made by supervisors and/or training staff member, including vendors, of the performance and competency of licensed operators during actual or simulated abnormal and emergency conditions.
- F. An annual review shall be made by Station Management of each licensee's performance in Sections A through D and a determination shall be made concerning the licensee's
