Gentlemen:

In your letter dated November 15, 1976 you stated that you were at that time unable to recommend a defensible schedule for the design, procurement and installation of a recirculation pump trip. We had requested a schedule for such a pump trip in our earlier letter dated August 31, 1976 from V. Stello to R. L. Bolger.

Your letter further stated that Commonwealth Edison would be able to provide a schedule for implementing the installation of a recirculation pump trip after February 1977 if the Nuclear Regulatory Commission concluded that such a pump trip is still necessary.

We have reviewed your November 15, 1976 request and the documents ^{1/2/} placed on the Quad Cities and Dresden dockets in support of that request, and have concluded that the recirculation pump trip requested by NRC in August 1976 is still necessary. Accordingly, as committed to in your November 12, 1976 letter, please provide us with a schedule for the installation of recirculation pump trips at Dresden Station Units No. 2 and 3 and Quad Cities Station Units No. 1 and 2.
