Dear Mr. Case:

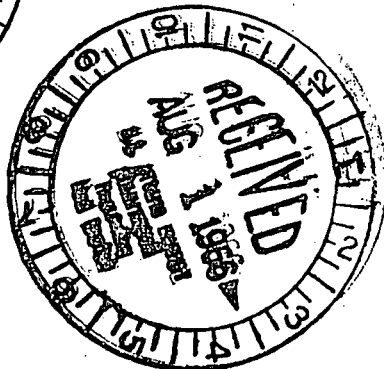
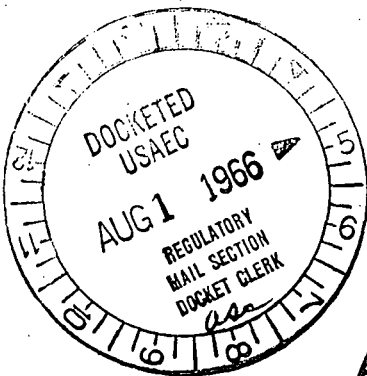
Confirming our telephone conversation yesterday and responsive to the staff's concern over the containment cooling system shared by Dresden 2 and 3, we now agree to provide two independent systems. Pump capacity of these independent systems will be resolved at a later date by mutual agreement between the applicant and the staff.

This will also confirm my statements on the following additional items:

1. When the staff and ACRS indicate that the material on Dresden 3 core cooling delivered by messenger from General Electric yesterday is acceptable, we will file an amendment to the Dresden 3 application incorporating such material therein.
2. The review of Dresden 1 in the light of considerations being given to projects now in the licensing stage will begin Monday, August 1, 1966.
