Dear Mr. Leedom:

The Pennsylvania Power and Light Company (PP&L) is planning on removing approximately 500 cubic yards of silt and sediment from in front of the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station Intake Structure in May 1985. This activity was previously conducted in 1983 and 1984. A maintenance plan was previously provided to the Department of the Army, Baltimore District, Corps of Engineers, on September 12, 1983, (PLE-3805).

This maintenance activity will be conducted by PP&L in an environmentally-sound manner in accordance with both Permit No. NABOP-F/4, September 9, 1976 and 33 CFR 325, Appendix A, which states:

"(a) That when the work authorized herein includes periodic maintenance dredging, it may be performed under this permit for--years from the date of issuance of this permit (ten years unless otherwise indicated);

"(b) That the permittee will advise the District Engineer in writing at least two weeks before he intends to undertake any maintenance dredging."

This material will be collected and used for fill or soil supplement on the station site.
