Dear Dr. Butler:

The purpose of this letter is to propose changes of an administrative nature to the Susquehanna SES Units 1 and 2 Technical Specifications. These changes involve a revision to our offsite organizational structure and clarifications of certain position titles.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGES

The following changes, which are illustrated in attached marked-up pages, are proposed for both the Unit 1 and Unit 2 Technical Specifications:

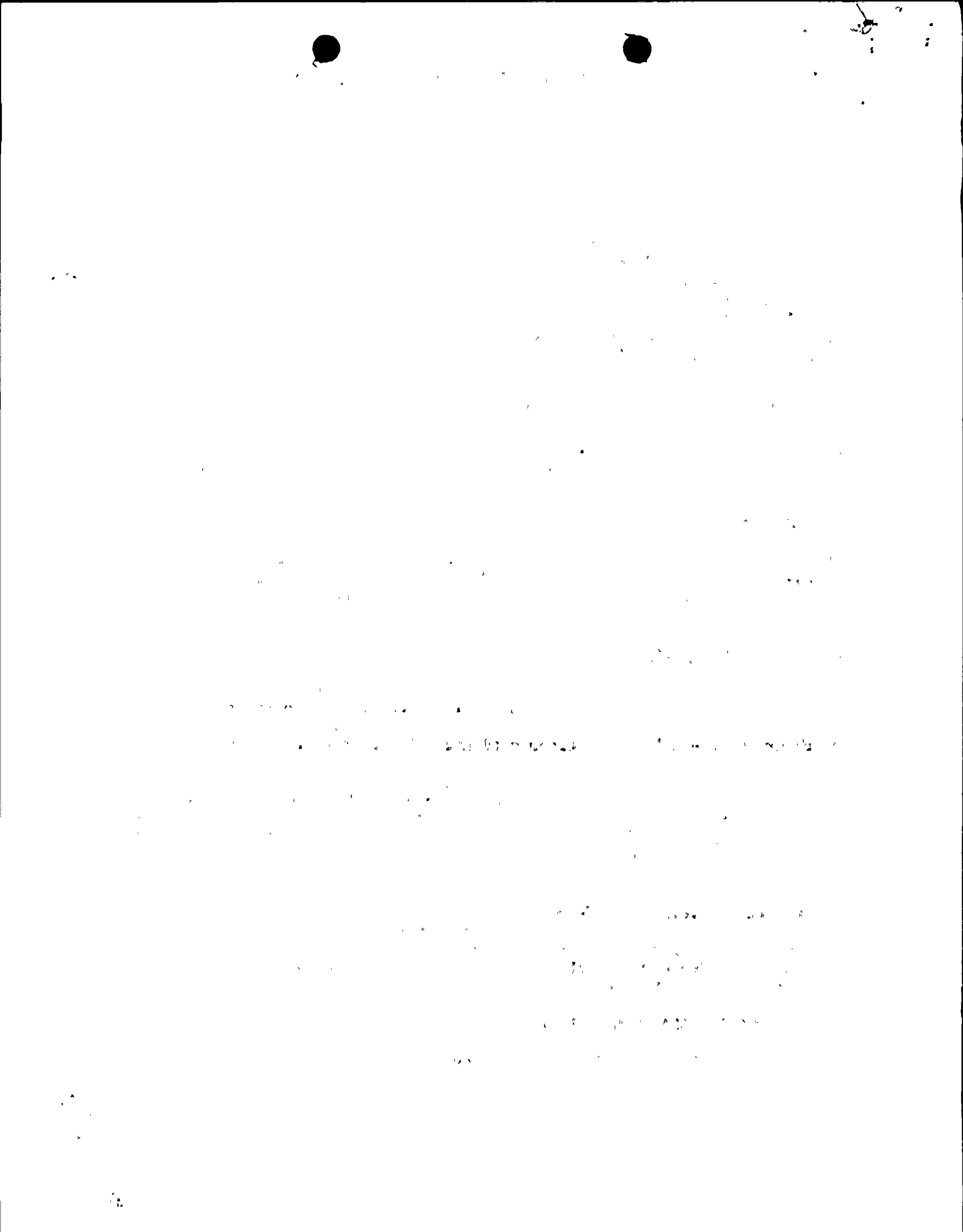
- o **Figure 6.2.1-1, "Offsite Organization":** The position of Manager-Nuclear Administration is deleted from the figure; the title Manager-Nuclear Support is revised to Manager-Nuclear Services; and the title Plant Superintendent-Susquehanna is changed to Superintendent of Plant-SSES. A change to delete the position of Manager-Nuclear Licensing, which was submitted via previously proposed amendments 107 and 59, is shown for information, and a revised figure incorporating all of these changes is provided.
- o **Subsection 6.8.2, page 6-15:** The title Nuclear Support Group is revised to Nuclear Services; the title Environmental Group Supervisor-Nuclear is revised to Environmental & Chemistry Group Supervisor-Nuclear; and the title Manager-Nuclear Support is revised to Manager-Nuclear Services.

NO SIGNIFICANT HAZARDS CONSIDERATIONS

The following three questions are addressed below for each of the proposed changes:

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- I. Does the proposed change involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident previously evaluated?
- II. Does the proposed change create the possibility of a new or different kind of accident from any accident previously evaluated?
- III. Does the proposed change involve a significant reduction in a margin of safety?

o Figure 6.2.1-1

- I. No. The deletion of the Manager-Nuclear Administration reflects PP&L's planned organization. This function has not been dropped, but merely realigned to report through the Manager-Nuclear Services. The revision of the title Manager-Nuclear Support to Manager-Nuclear Services is in recognition of the increased number of functions reporting through that position (they currently include Radiological & Environmental Services, Nuclear Maintenance Services, and Planning & Licensing Services; they will soon include Nuclear Administration and Nuclear Planning & Controls). The rewording of the plant superintendent's title is merely a clarification for accuracy; his function is in no way altered. These changes are clearly administrative in nature and as such pose no impact on the safe operation of Susquehanna SES.
- II. No. See I above.
- III. No. See I above.

o Subsection 6.8.2

- I. No. The proposal reflecting the change from Nuclear Support to Nuclear Services was discussed above. The revision of the Environmental Group Supervisor title to reflect his responsibility over the chemistry function is a clarification to reflect the actual position title. This change has no impact on the scope of his environmental responsibilities and therefore poses no impact on the procedure reviews that are the subject of the affected paragraph. Based on the above, all of the proposed changes to Subsection 6.8.2 have no impact on safety and are entirely administrative in nature.
- II. No. See I above.
- III. No. See I above.

IMPLEMENTATION

On April 1, 1988, PP&L's current Senior Vice President-Nuclear will be transferring to another position within the company, and his position will be assumed by the current Vice President-Nuclear Operations. In order to facilitate this transition in department top management, PP&L requests that these proposed changes be permitted to take effect on March 1, 1988. This will optimize the span of control of the Senior Vice President-Nuclear in recognition that the position of Vice President-Nuclear Operations will not immediately be filled.
