- The emergency planning rule should be same for NuScale as any other nuclear reactor.
- The NuScale facility is not small. It would be a cluster of one dozen 50 MW reactors equivalent to one 600MG reactor and in an emergency the results could be large.
- There is no evidence that new reactors will be safer than old ones. These “safer” reactors have no track record since they haven’t been built.
- The rules should not be changed just because the nuclear industry’s claims they will be safer.
- The proposed rule is flawed because a single small reactor could still have a large release.
- Tell the NRC that the rules should protect public health in the event of a nuclear reactor accident.
