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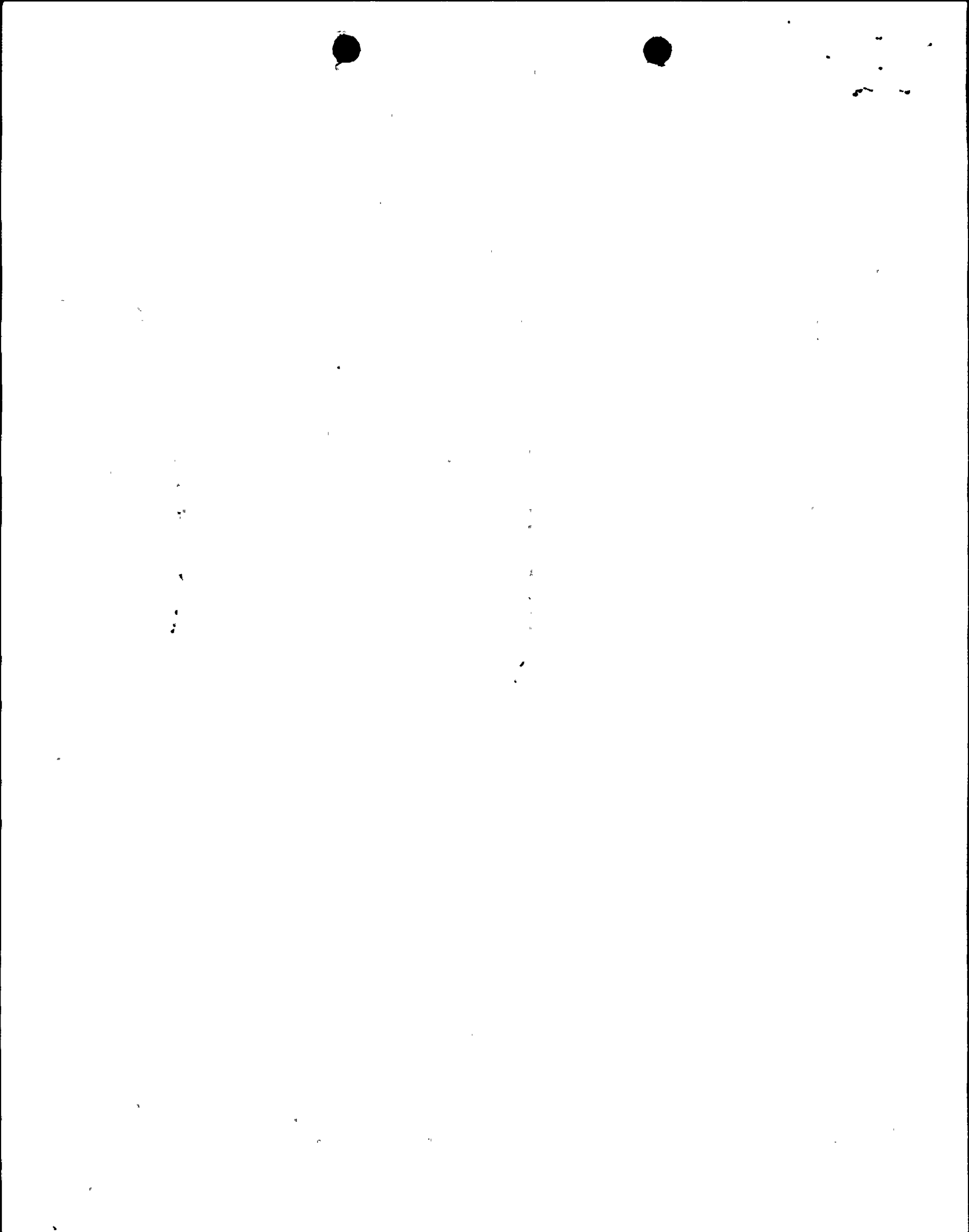

Dear Dr. Butler:

Referenced letters 1, 2, and 3 provided the necessary documentation to justify extended operation with one recirculation loop out of service during Cycle 2 of Susquehanna SES Unit 2. Although Cycle 2 is now over, a staff evaluation of that analysis is still needed to fully document the acceptability of our Unit 2 Cycle 3 reload submittal (Reference 4). This is because the analysis provided in support of Proposed Amendment 52 was referenced as part of the justification for single loop operation during Unit 2 Cycle 3.

Based on the above, PP&L hereby withdraws from further consideration the Technical Specification changes presented in Proposed Amendment 52, but we also request that a safety evaluation of that proposal be issued in time to support the staff's ongoing review of our Cycle 3 reload submittal.
