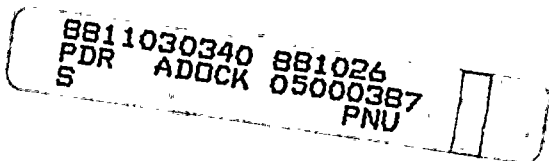
As discussed during our October 24, 1988 telephone conversation, the Pennsylvania Power and Light Company requests an Emergency Permit for a temporary tie-in of the site well system (PWS ID 2400994) to the domestic water system normally supplied by the river water treatment system (PWS ID 2400998). The tie-in is necessary while the mixing impeller in the river water treatment system clarifier is serviced.

As indicated this repair should be completed and the reactivator returned to service within 30 days. In the interim, well water will supply the clarified water storage tank and will be chlorinated prior to entering the domestic water system.

As we discussed PP&L fully intends to comply with the special condition for issuance of this permit, which requires the permanent well cross-tie modification to be completed by December 31, 1988. I will keep you informed of the status of the temporary and permanent well tie-ins. If you have additional concerns or questions please contact me at (215) 770-7891.
