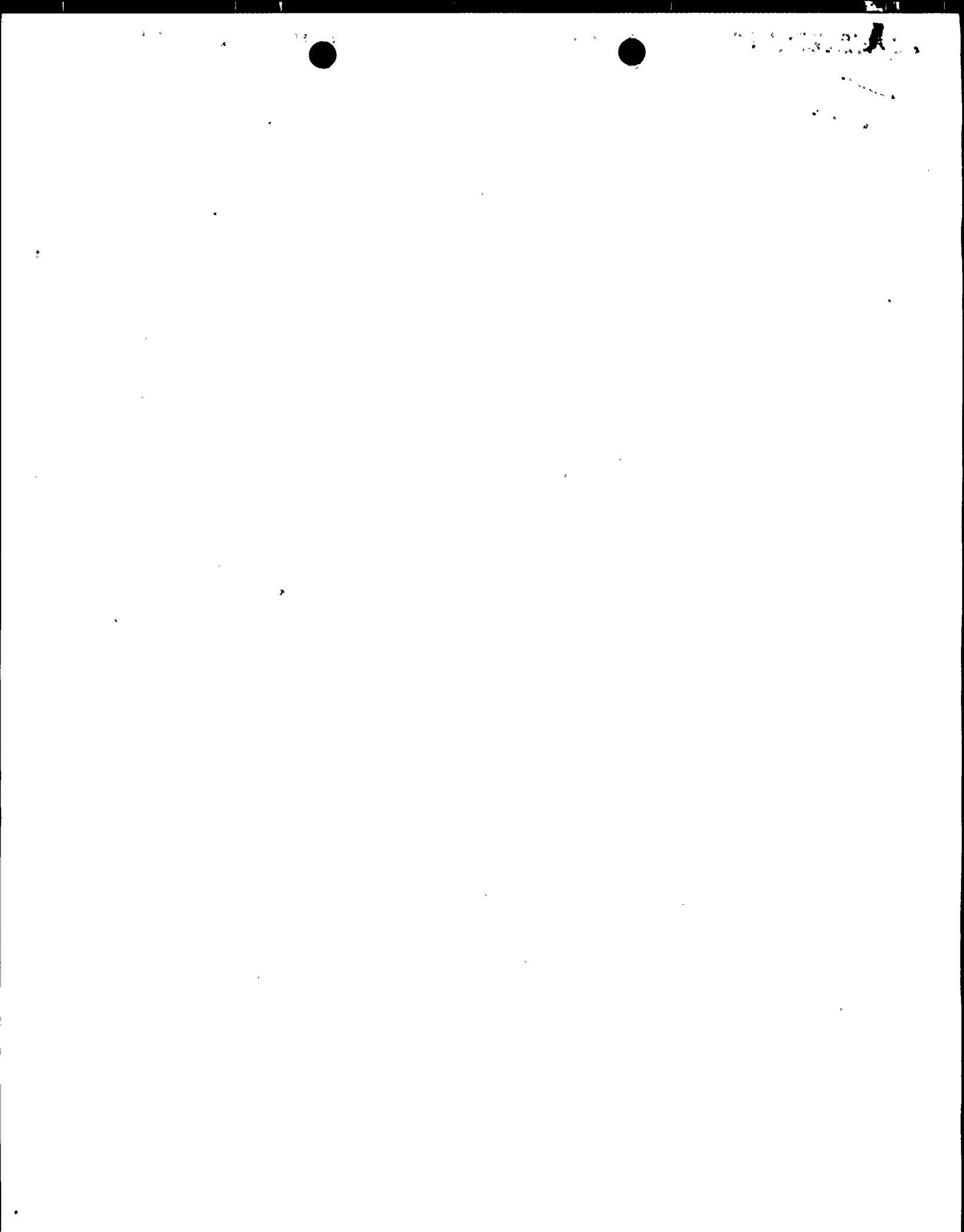

Dear Mr. Council:

The Pennsylvania Power and Light (PP&L) has completed maintenance cleaning of the discharge diffuser at the Susquehanna SES. This activity was conducted between July 17 and 21, 1989. Approximately 7.5 cubic yards of river silt and sediment were removed from the diffuser pipe and discharged to the Susquehanna River.

As I discussed with a member of your staff during a telephone conversation on July 18, 1989, in accordance with Condition (9) of the permit, PP&L is notifying The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources of maintenance dredging activities for the diffuser pipe. The Pennsylvania Fish Commission and Luzerne County Conversation District were also notified in accordance with Special Conditions A and B of this permit.

As required in Condition 10 of the permit, PP&L certifies that:

"The maintenance dredging of the Susquehanna SES diffuser pipe was performed in accordance with this permit and the approved maps, plans, profiles, and specifications provided in the permit application."

A copy of this letter will be provided to the Pennsylvania Fish Commission and Luzerne County Conversation District as required by permit Special Conditions A and B.

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Dear Mr. Roeseke:

Then Pennsylvania Power and Light has completed maintenance cleaning of the discharge diffuser at the Susquehanna SES. This activity was conducted between July 17 and 21, 1989. Approximately 7.5 cubic yards of river silt and sediment were removed from the diffuser pipe and discharged to the Susquehanna River.

As I discussed with Mr. John Gible of the Corps. of Engineers (COE) during a telephone conversation on July 18, 1989, Special Condition (b) of this permit was not met. This condition requires at least two weeks written notice to the Corps of Engineers prior to undertaking any maintenance dredging. Inadvertently, due to a scheduling change (fall to summer) the Environmental and Chemistry Group (E&CG) was not aware of this activity until it commenced. It is the responsibility of the E&CG to notify the COE prior to maintenance.

To meet Special Condition (b), Susquehanna SES Construction Staff has agreed to notify the Environmental and Chemistry Group prior to either diffuser discharge pipe or the intake structure maintenance in the future.
