Dear Dr. Butler:

Via references 1 and 2, PP&L submitted Proposed Amendment 34 to the Susquehanna SES Unit 2 Operating License (NPF-22). The proposal consisted of changes to the Technical Specifications in support of modifications to enhance the capability of the Drywell Cooling system. Reference 3 requested that the proposal be held in abeyance due to a PP&L decision to delay the modifications. Through references 4 and 5 PP&L requested that the proposed amendment 34 be cancelled, again due to delays in implementing the

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modification. Reference 6 requested the proposed amendment, now amendment 72, be reinstated with approval prior to the Unit 2 refueling and inspection outage scheduled to begin September 9, 1989.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that this modification will be performed during the Unit 2 fourth refueling and inspection outage, which is currently scheduled to begin in March, 1991. Consequently, we request that proposed amendment 72 be approved prior to the start of the March, 1991 outage, and that the approval be conditioned to become effective prior to startup following that outage.
