The GL 90-03 requested that all licensees and applicants review their present vendor interface programs and modify them as necessary using the guidance provided in GL 90-03.

By letter dated September 27, 1990, you responded to GL 90-03 and indicated that the existing programs in conjunction with the upgrade for vendor interface on key safety-related components, will meet the guidance provided in GL 90-03. The staff has reviewed your response and finds that the existing programs and proposed upgrades are acceptable. Accordingly, TAC NOS. 76302 and 76303 are being closed.
