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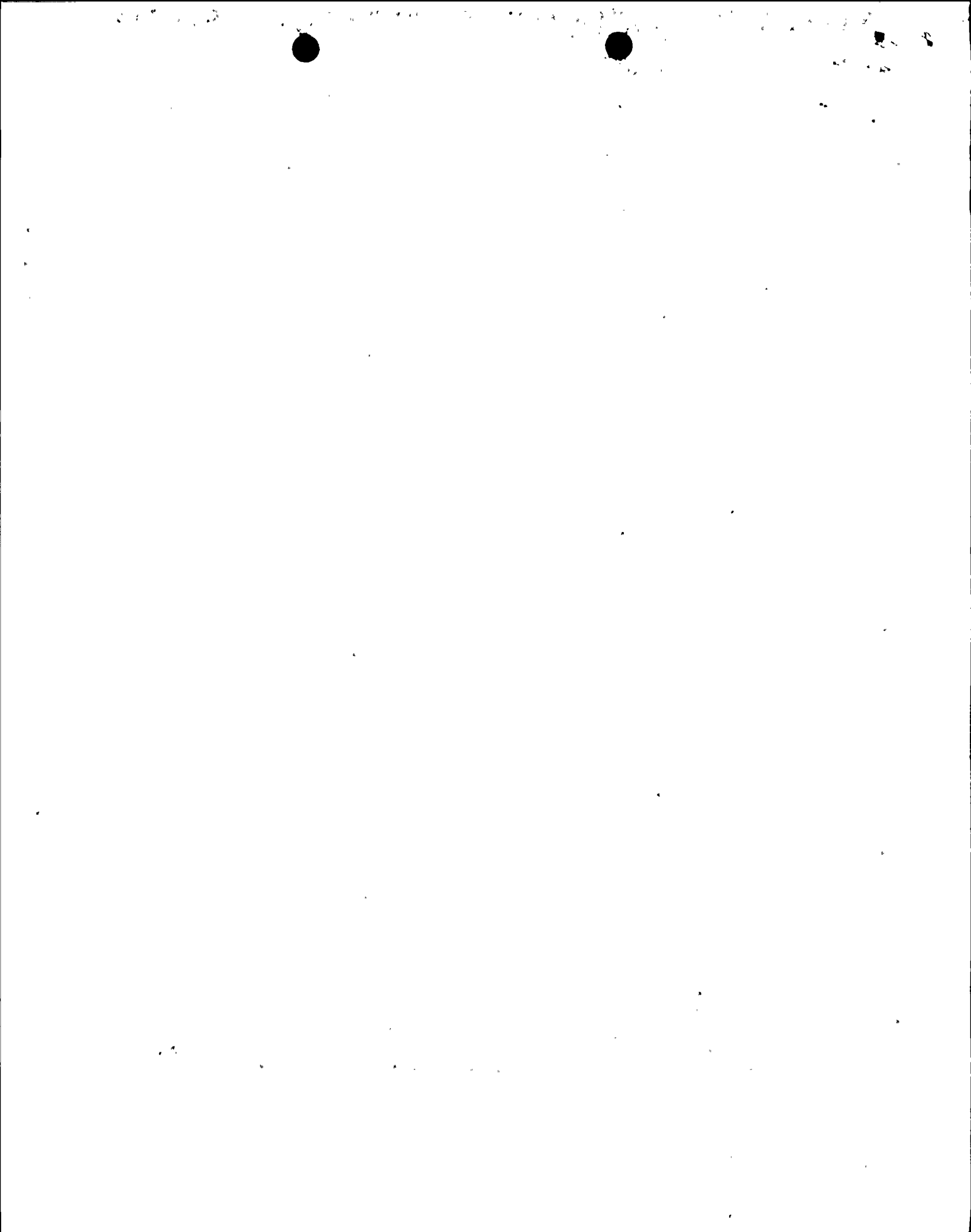

Dear Mr. Martin:

In response to Generic Letter 89-13, "Service Water System Problems Affecting Safety-Related Equipment," PP&L committed to have several activities complete by the end of the Unit 1 fifth refueling and inspection outage, which ended in mid-November, 1990. In response to the Generic Letter requirement for a submittal within 30 days confirming that each of the activities were completed, please be advised of the following status:

ITEM 1: PP&L will have procedures in place to inspect the plant intake and the ESW/RHRSW intakes at the spray pond (Reference 1).

STATUS: Both procedures are currently in place.

ITEM 2: PP&L will perform a design basis review of heat exchangers not reviewed under the 1988 ESW SSFI that fall within the scope of GL 89-13 (Reference 1).

STATUS: Complete.

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ITEM 3: PP&L will have a program for ultrasonic and radiographic testing of ESW and RHRSW in place.

STATUS: To date, PP&L has completed identification of test locations. This does not constitute a program to meet our commitment. The program is still under development, and has been delayed due to an internal reevaluation of the use of radiography as part of the program. Based on this delay, PP&L is revising our commitment date for having the program in place to be the end of the upcoming Unit 2 fourth refueling and inspection outage, which is currently scheduled for May 10, 1991.
