Mr. Hill:

In order to continue the review of your application to renew your NRC license, we need additional information. If you have any questions, please contact me (610-337-5089).

1. In your renewal application dated May 15, 2017, Item 3, you indicated that the licensed material will be stored in Hagerhill, Kentucky. Kentucky is an Agreement State and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) does not have the authority to authorize a storage location in Kentucky. Your present license authorizes storage of material at 4022 Ohio River Road, Huntington, WV as well as use at temporary job sites in any area where the NRC maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of the material. Please confirm if you plan to continue to store material at the 4022 Ohio River Road address or at another storage address in West Virginia. You can store licensed material in Kentucky under the authorization of an Agreement State license issued by Kentucky and use your renewed NRC license for authorization to perform licensed activities at temporary jobsites in WV or other areas of NRC jurisdiction. Please state where you plan to use and store licensed material.
2. Item 8.5 of NUREG-1556 Volume 1, Rev. 2 "Program- Specific Guidance About Portable Gauge Licenses", states that applicants must provide a description of the radionuclide and quantities to be used as well as the manufacturer and model number of the devices and sealed sources. If the radioactive material on your current license will meet your business needs, you may request what is presently authorized. Otherwise please describe the radioactive material, quantities, sealed sources, and portable gauges in a format similar to Conditions 6, 7, 8, and 9 of your current license.
3. In your application dated May 15, 2017, Item 7, you are designating Robert Hill as the Radiation Safety Officer. NUREG-1556 Volume 1, Rev. 2 "Program- Specific Guidance About Portable Gauge Licenses", directs you to submit documentation demonstrating that the proposed RSO is qualified by training and experience to perform the duties of the RSO. Please submit a certificate of completion of the RSO's course and/or the authorized users' course.
4. Please confirm that your authorized users will have received training as described in section 8.8.1 of NUREG-1556 Volume 1, Rev. 2 "Program- Specific Guidance About Portable Gauge Licenses", before using licensed materials.
5. In your renewal application dated May 15, 2017, you did not provide details describing your radiation safety program as specified in section 8.10 of NUREG-1556 Volume 1, Rev. 2 "Program- Specific Guidance About Portable Gauge Licenses." You may use Appendix B of this NUREG to provide the requested

information. I have enclosed the link to the NUREG for your convenience.
