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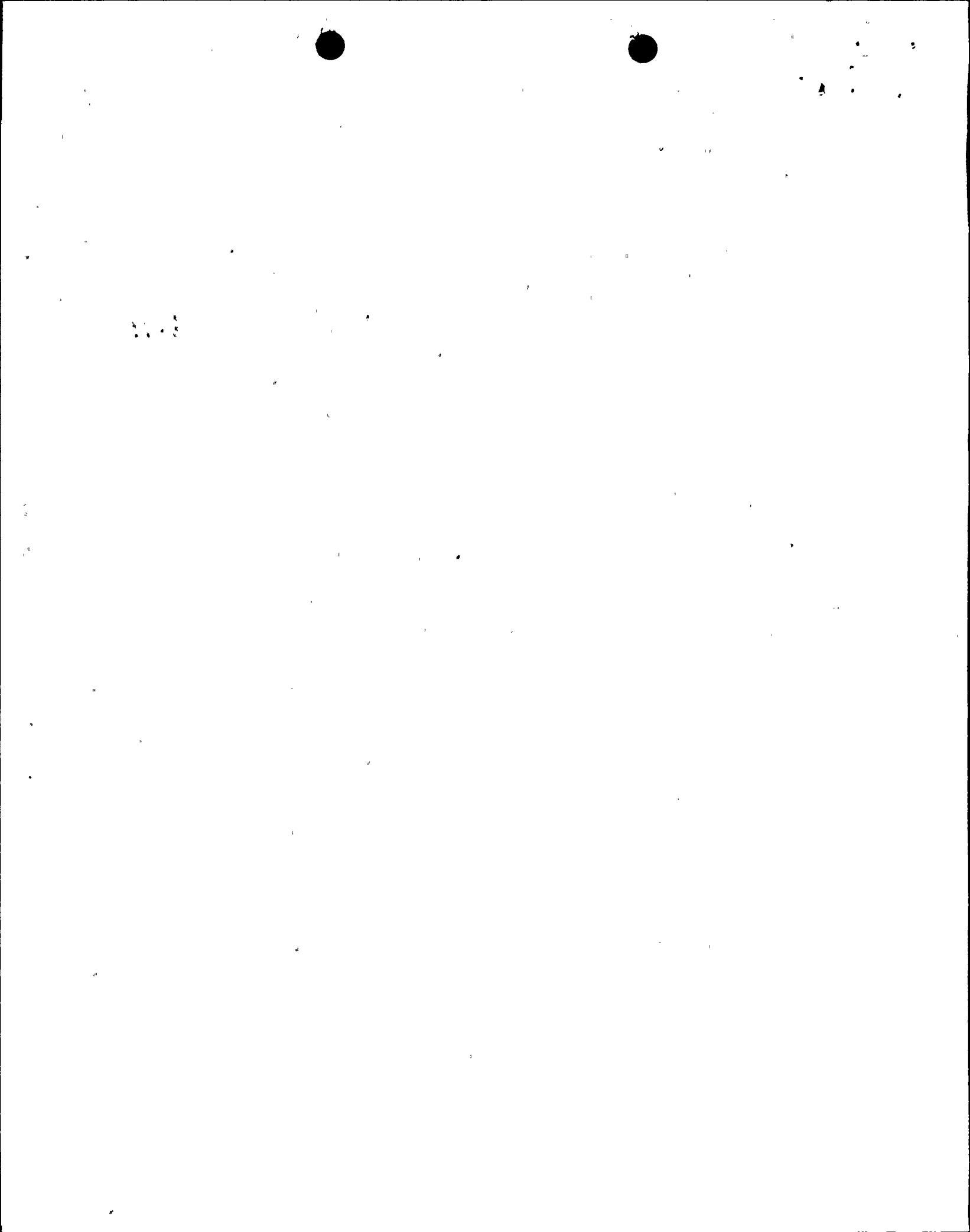

Pursuant to Part A, 3.b.(1) of NPDES Permit No. PA 0047325, enclosed is the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station discharge monitoring report for August 1992. Also enclosed is Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources' Monthly Facility Report Form (01-112).

There were no noncompliances in August 1992.

Daily biocide treatment of the Circulating Water System with the Gaseous Chlorine Injection System was discontinued after August 10, 1992. Beginning on August 13, 1992 Betz Clam-Trol replaced chlorine and was used once a week per unit as a general biocide. Analysis for free available chlorine at Outfall 071, Cooling Tower Blowdown was discontinued once gaseous chlorine injection was eliminated.
