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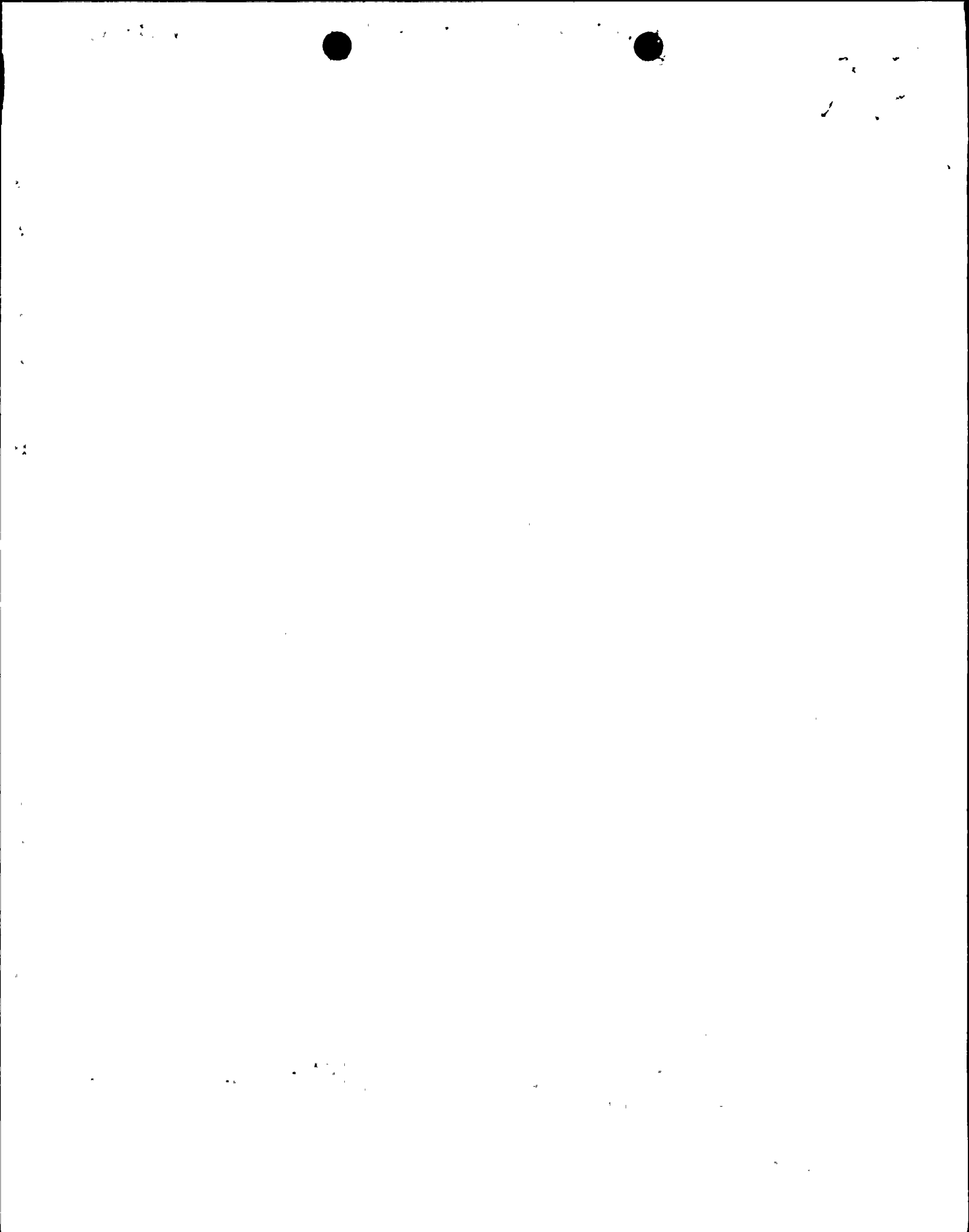

Thank you for your letter of December 24, 1992 acknowledging our letters concerning the subject report.

This letter is to clarify two items in your letter of acknowledgment.

First, we have thus far transmitted two letters to the NRC concerning the subject report, not including this letter. The first letter was dated November 27, 1992, not November 13, 1992 as stated in your letter. The second letter was dated December 14, 1992 as you stated.

Second, your description of your understanding of our concerns outlines a scenario which includes one unit in refueling and a LOCA in the other unit with a concurrent loss of offsite power. Although our concerns are applicable for this scenario, as we stated in our report and the documents which were attached, it is just one of many scenarios in which our concerns would be applicable. We would therefore request that you do not limit your evaluations or your requests for the licensee to address these concerns just to that scenario.
