Pursuant to Part A, 3.b.(1) of NPDES Permit No. PA 0047325, enclosed is the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station discharge monitoring report for December 1992. Also enclosed is Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources' Monthly Facility Report Form (01-112).

There were no noncompliances in December.

An additional 55 gallons of glycerin solution was discharged to the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) on December 1, 1992. Previously, in November 1992, approximately 600 gallons of this 50:50 glycerin:water solution was discharged to the STP.
