In a telephone call this afternoon, Mr. Richard Clark asked if we would have any objection to the placement in the NRC Public Document Room of our letter dated August 13, 1993 to you. We hereby authorize the NRC to place that letter and every preceding letter from us related to our 10CFR21 report in the Public Document Room. All future correspondence from us on this subject may also be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

Mr. Clark indicated that we raised the new matter of PP&L's nuclear safety program on page 17 of our August 13, 1993 letter. Having reviewed that letter, we respectfully point out that we identified our concerns with PP&L's handling of nuclear safety issues in the 10CFR21 report dated November 27, 1992. Specifically, the paragraph at the bottom of page 5 and continuing onto page 6 describes the programmatic failures of PP&L's nuclear safety program. We expended considerable effort to document all of our concerns in that 10CFR21 report. We have no "new" concerns to bring to your attention. Unfortunately, PP&L's work to date has not resolved any of our "old" concerns as we will cover in our presentation to the NRC on November 1, 1993.
