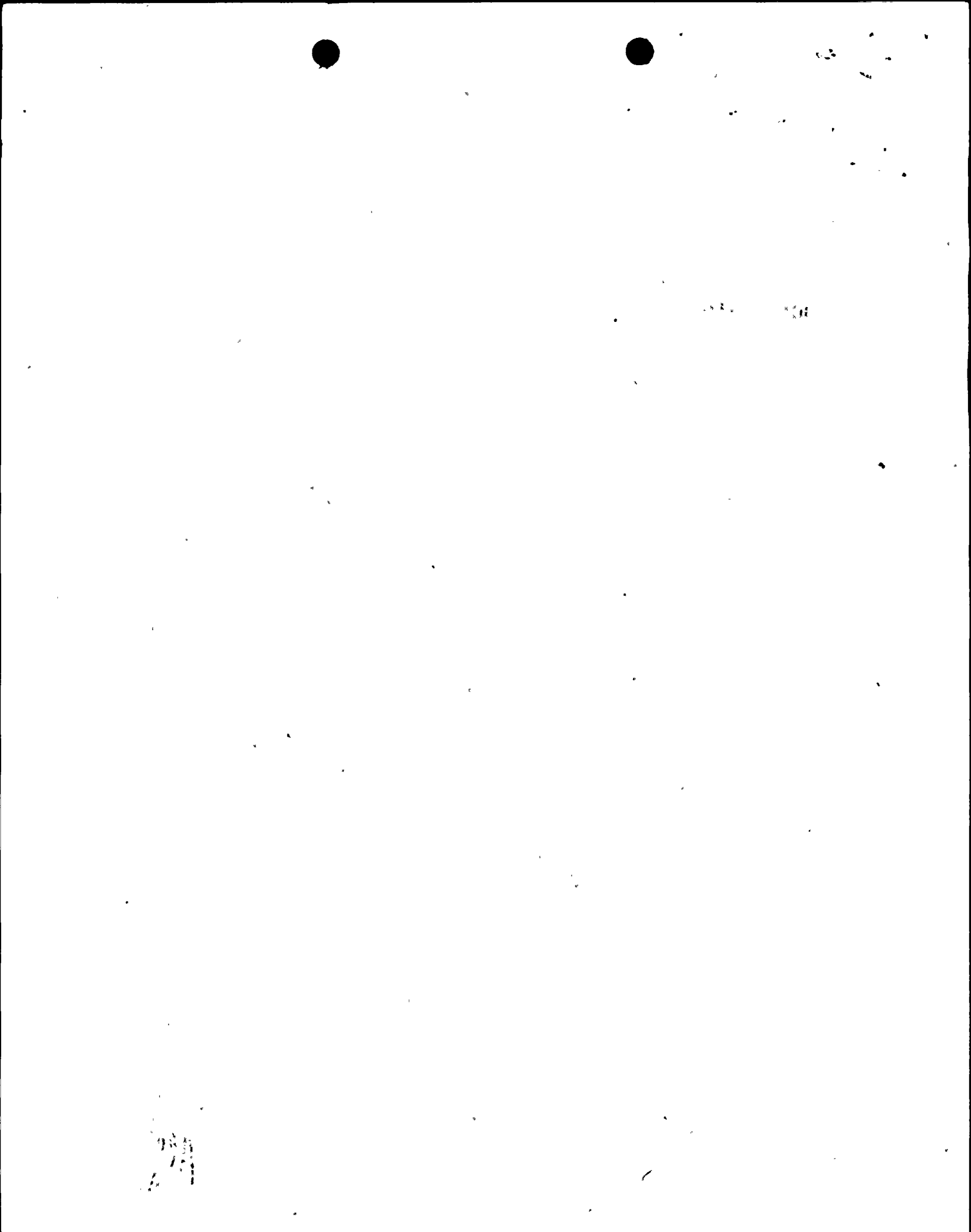
Pursuant to the referenced letter, PP&L has evaluated the information provided and determined that the physical examination records reviewed did not completely comply with the instructions identified on a PP&L form. PP&L therefore determined that: 1) the failure to comply with the instructions on the form did not jeopardize personnel health or safety, 2) compliance with regulatory requirements were maintained, and 3) based on our evaluation, the failure to comply was limited to one contractor.

In response to the identified condition the following actions are being taken: 1) the affected governing procedure will be evaluated and revised as necessary to clearly state requirements for contractors, and compliance to it will be achieved, 2) the form used to document the required actions will be revised to be consistent with the governing procedure, and 3) appropriate contract personnel will be counseled as to PP&L's expectations and the need to follow instructions explicitly.

Attachment 1 to this letter provides details of PP&L's evaluation that should be withheld from public disclosure. Therefore, PP&L requests that Attachment 1 to this letter be Exempt from Public Disclosure in accordance with 10CFR2.790(a).


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PP&L considers the corrective actions stated above to satisfactorily address the issue concerning physical examination records that was identified in the referenced letter.
