Pennsylvania Power & Light (PP&L) Company, the licensee for the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, requests a deviation from the guidance associated with 10 CFR 73.56 concerning personnel access authorization requirements, and an exemption to 10 CFR 73.57 concerning requirements for criminal history checks of individuals granted unescorted access. Specifically, PP&L requests an extension of the reinstatement period for access authorization from 365 days to 2 years for PP&L employees who have periodic duties at Susquehanna SES.

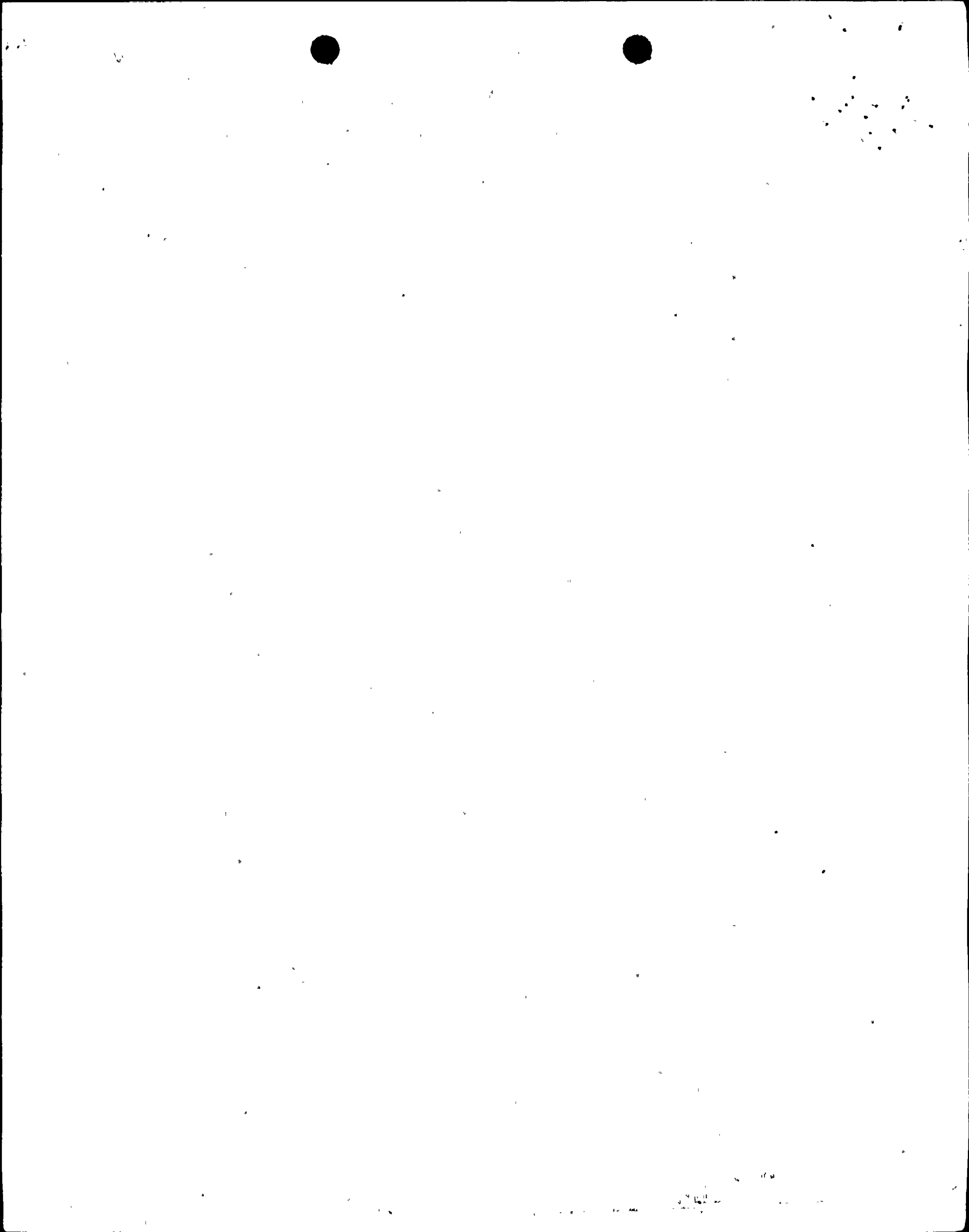
PP&L has reviewed the requirements of 10 CFR 73.56 and 73.57, and has determined that the intent of these regulations will continue to be met under the proposed changes. PP&L bases this conclusion on the fact that the requested changes will only be applied to PP&L employees, and that PP&L employees are subject to a variety of documented company policies which are intended to ensure that these individuals are trustworthy and reliable. Further, the findings from these policies will be reviewed prior to reinstating access authorization. A discussion of the basis for the proposed changes is attached to this letter. The attached analysis concludes that the proposed exemption involves no significant hazards. The proposed exemption has been reviewed by the Susquehanna Review Committee.

PP&L has been reducing the number of individuals that maintain access authorization to Susquehanna SES, both to reduce program administrative costs and eliminate access authorization for individuals who no longer have a need to access Susquehanna SES. The requested changes support the reductions in the number of individuals who maintain ongoing access authorization to Susquehanna SES, but at the same time allow for timely, cost efficient



reinstatement to support plant work. PP&L is pursuing these changes as Cost Beneficial Licensing Actions to reduce training costs, processing fees, and lost production associated with access authorization requirements. PP&L estimates the benefit of the proposed changes at approximately \$107,000 per year.
