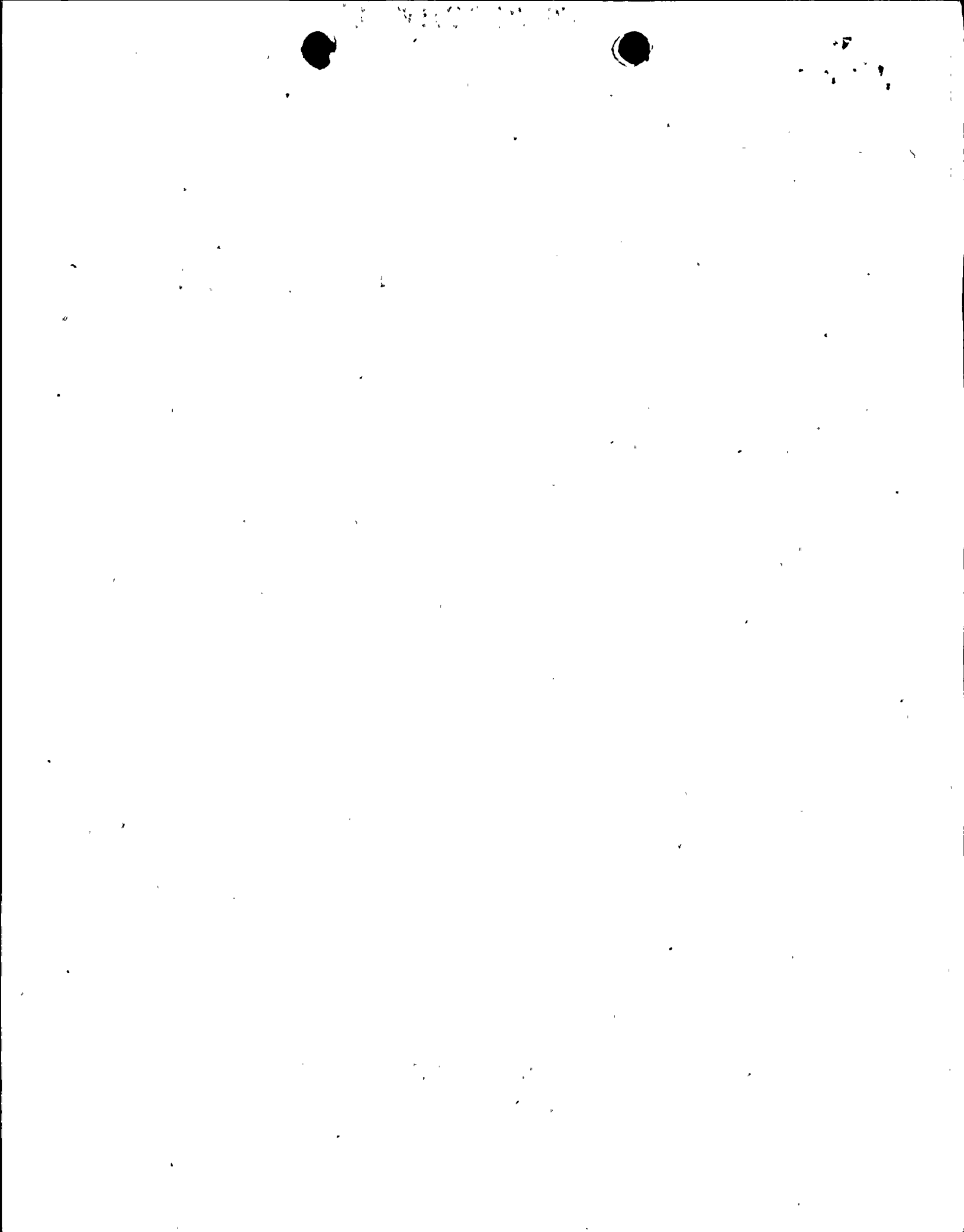

The purpose of this letter is to propose a change to the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station (SSES) Unit 2 Technical Specifications. The proposed change precludes the need for entry into Limiting Condition of Operation (LCO) 3.0.3 to allow the performance of certain Emergency Diesel Generator testing.

The attached assessment discusses the safety basis for this proposed change and concludes that the change involves no significant hazards.
