Reference: Letter (PLA-4376) dated November 14, 1995, from R. G. Byram (PP&L) to NRC Document Control Desk.

In the above reference letter, Pennsylvania Power & Light Company requested relief from the requirements of Section 4.3 of NUREG-0619. During recent discussions with the NRC Staff, the staff stated that the requested relief would not be reviewed since this is a generic issue and the BWROG has provided a generic relief request submittal on this issue. The staff intends to review the generic submittal prior to reviewing plant specific submittals.

PP&L, therefore, requests that the requirements of Section 4.3 of NUREG-0619 be deferred for both Susquehanna units until the BWROG generic submittal on this issue is resolved. The basis for requesting relief from the requirements of Section 4.3 of NUREG-0619 are applicable to this request for deferral of those requirements. The bases are stated in the above referenced letter and the BWROG's generic submittal.

Since the Unit 1 liquid penetrant examinations are required to be done in the next outage (scheduled for September 1996), we request that this request for deferral be approved by March 1, 1996 in order to support the work to be done in the outage.


