

On July 1, 1996 NRC Staff sent a request for additional information regarding Pennsylvania Power & Light Company's revised Emergency Action Levels (EALs) in the Emergency Plan. Upon review of the requested information, it is apparent that there are two major issues that affect the format and content of the entire EAL revision. These two issues include the use of Initiating Conditions and the Barrier Matrix. PP&L has decided to initiate a team to study these issues as well as to reassess the broad issue of the expected benefits of implementing the new EALs. To allow sufficient time to study these issues and develop a plan to address them, PP&L will not be able to respond to the RAI by the requested date of November 1, 1996. After completing our broad-based study but prior to performance of the detailed changes to the EALs, we propose to meet with the NRC Staff to discuss the approach and get NRC feedback. After this meeting with the NRC Staff, we would submit PP&L's response to the RAI. PP&L expects that we can support a meeting in January 1997 and potentially, depending on the feedback received, complete the response to the RAI by the end of the first quarter of 1997.

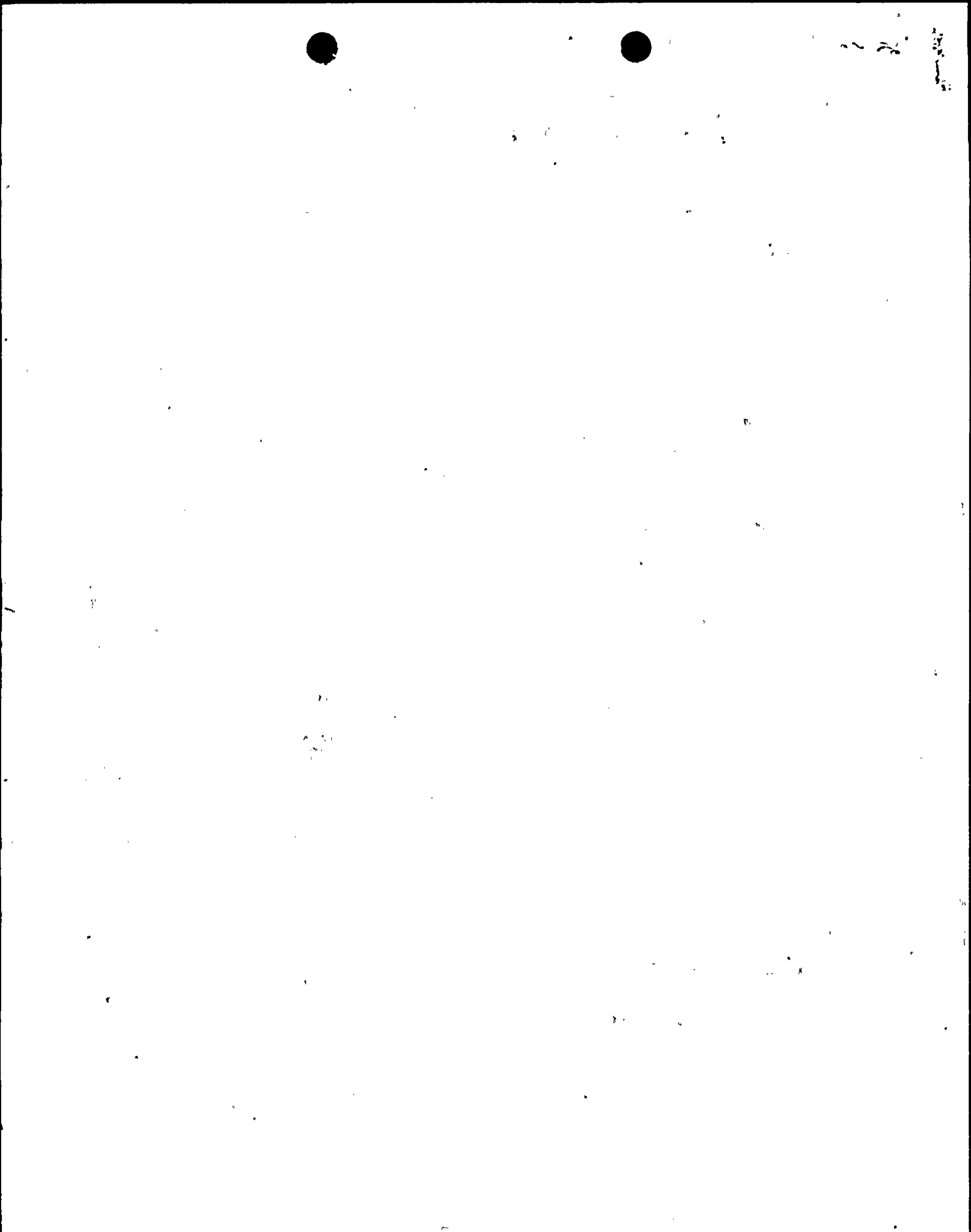


