Pursuant to the Environmental Protection Plan, the following information concerning a revision to Susquehanna SES NPDES permit No. PA 0047325 is provided.

On October 3, 1996, PP&L submitted a letter to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PaDEP), in accordance with Permitting Guidance on Conditioned Water Discharges and Use of Chemical Additives, requesting: 1) use of Towebrom 960 as a water treatment biocide, and 2) discharging miscellaneous wastestreams to either the Cooling Tower Blowdown or storm drains.

In accordance with the above noted guidance document, if no response is received from the PaDEP within 60 days the request is approved. No response was received from the PaDEP; therefore, use of Towerbrom 960 and initiation of miscellaneous discharges to either blowdown or storm drains can begin.

Additionally the PaDEP was notified that the following individuals are authorized to sign Monthly NPDES Discharge Monitoring Reports for the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station. They are:


