On October 28, 1996 PP&L sent a letter to the NRC (Reference 1) providing a revised schedule for responding to your staff's request for additional information. PP&L's plan was to assess the expected benefits of implementing the new Emergency Action Levels (EALs), given that the NRC had two major concerns with PP&L's proposed EALs which we believe would require significant resources to resolve. PP&L has completed that assessment and decided to cancel the revision to the EALs.

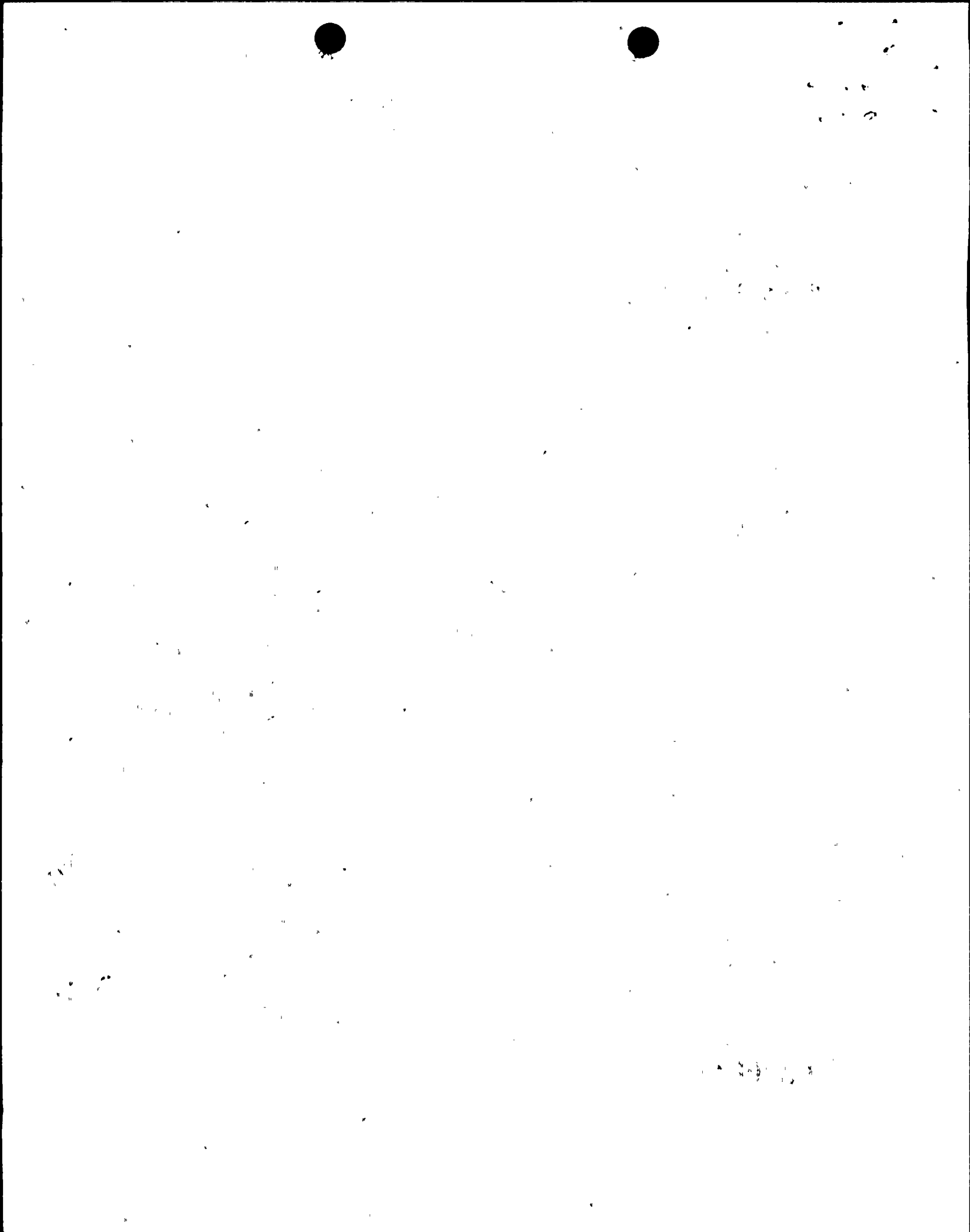
The current EALs meet the requirements of NUREG-0654 and have been revised a number of times to improve clarity and remove ambiguity since the original submittal proposing implementation of the NUMARC NESP-007 approach (i.e., January 1993). The Susquehanna SES operators and Emergency Planning staff are thoroughly trained and proficient in the use of the current EALs. Therefore, at this time PP&L believes that cancellation of the proposed revision to the EALs that implements NUMARC NESP-007 is appropriate.

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
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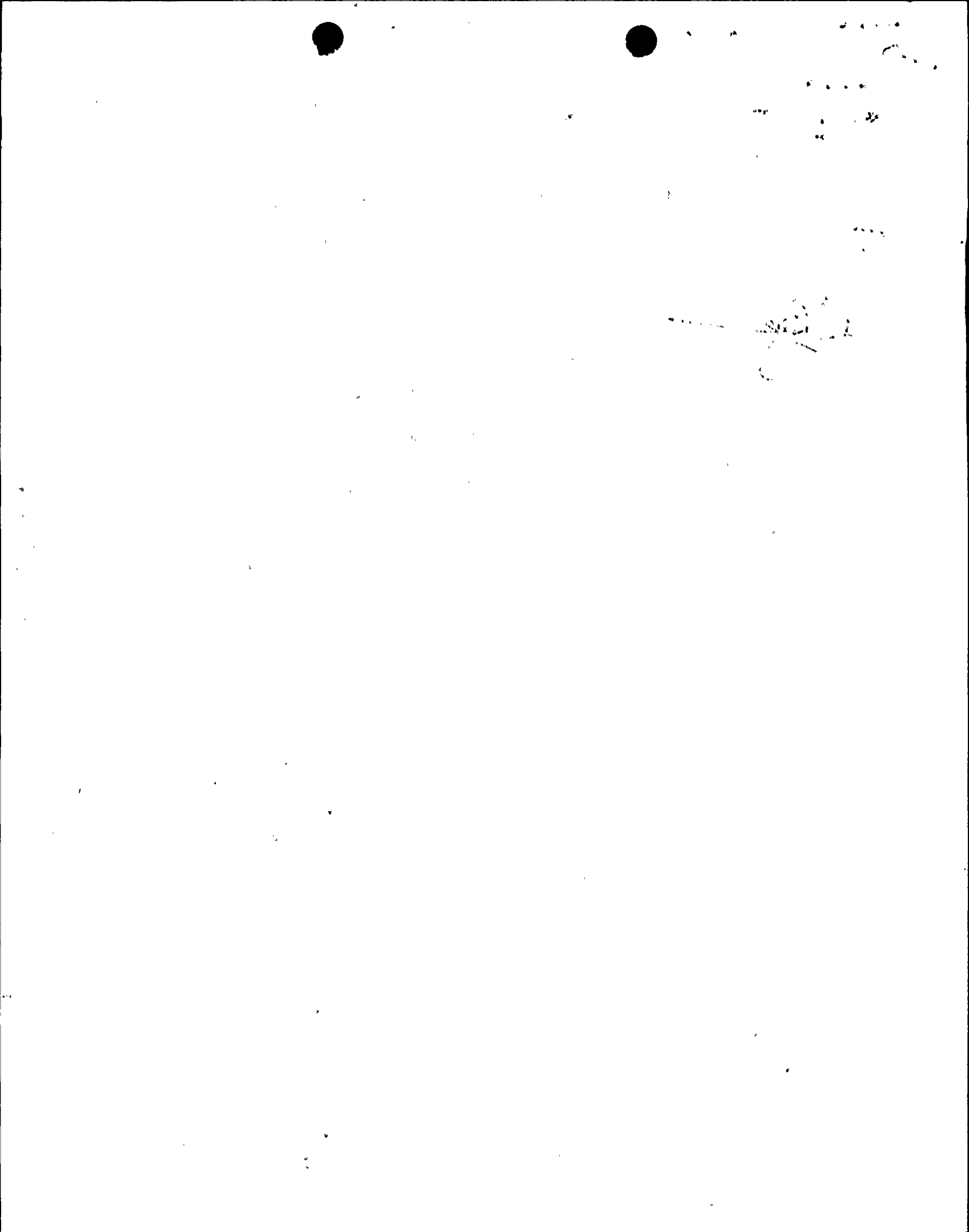

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
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
