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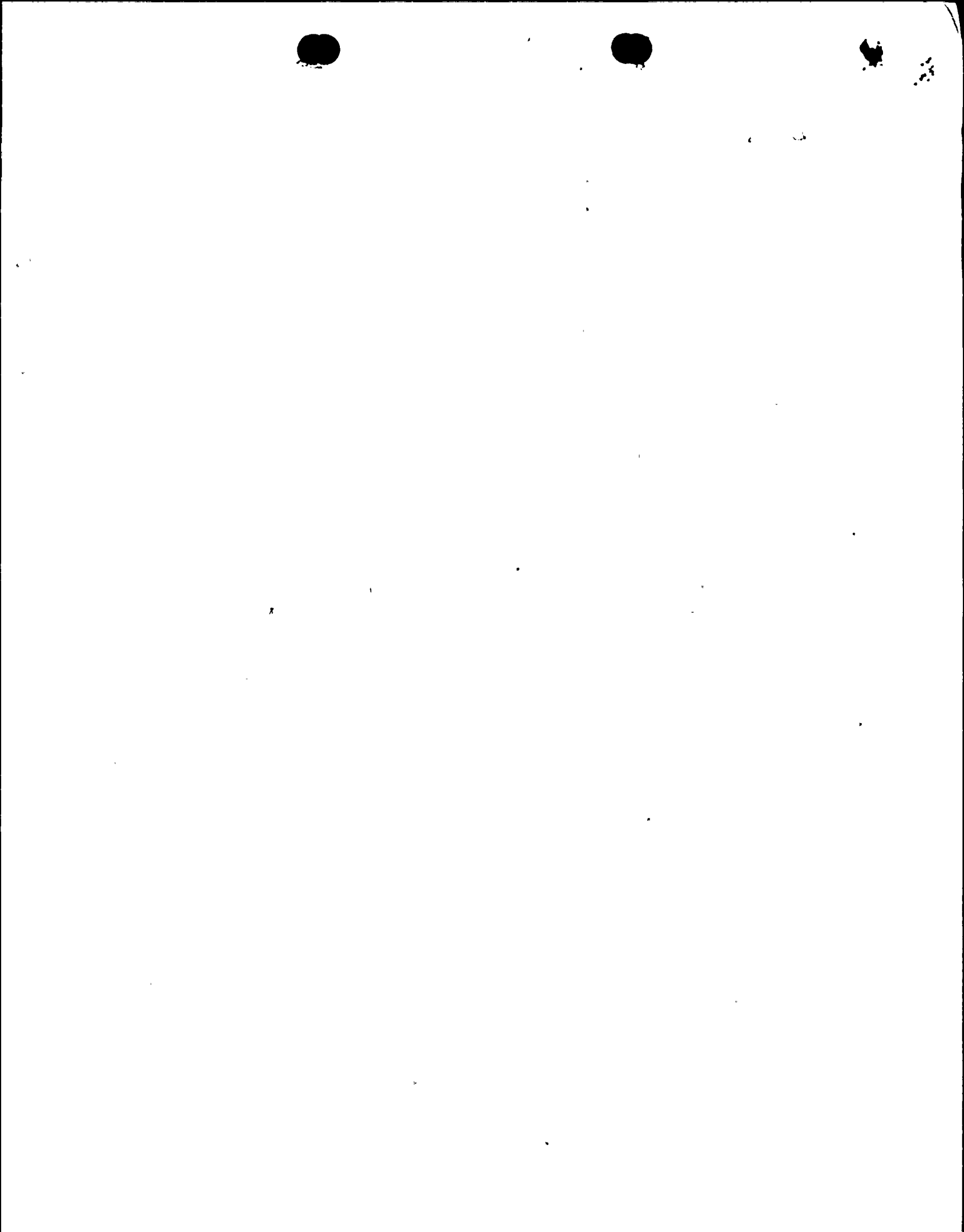

PP&L is requesting enforcement discretion from Unit 2 Technical Specifications 3/4.3.7.5 (Accident Monitoring Instrumentation) and 3/4.4.2 (Safety/Relief Valves) as they apply to the inoperable "J" acoustic monitor.


The following footnote is proposed to be applied to Table 3.3.7.5-1, Instrument 9, Required Number of Channels and Minimum Channels Operable; Table 4.3.7.5-1, Instrument 9, Channel Check and Channel Calibration; LCO 3.4.2, Action c; and Surveillance Requirement 4.4.2:

"Compliance with these requirements for the "J" SRV acoustic monitor is not required for the period beginning June 15, 1998, until the next unit shutdown of sufficient duration to allow for containment entry, not to exceed the ninth refueling and inspection outage."

Due to an oversight, the referenced request did not indicate application of this footnote to Surveillance Requirement 4.4.2. Corrected marked up pages are attached.

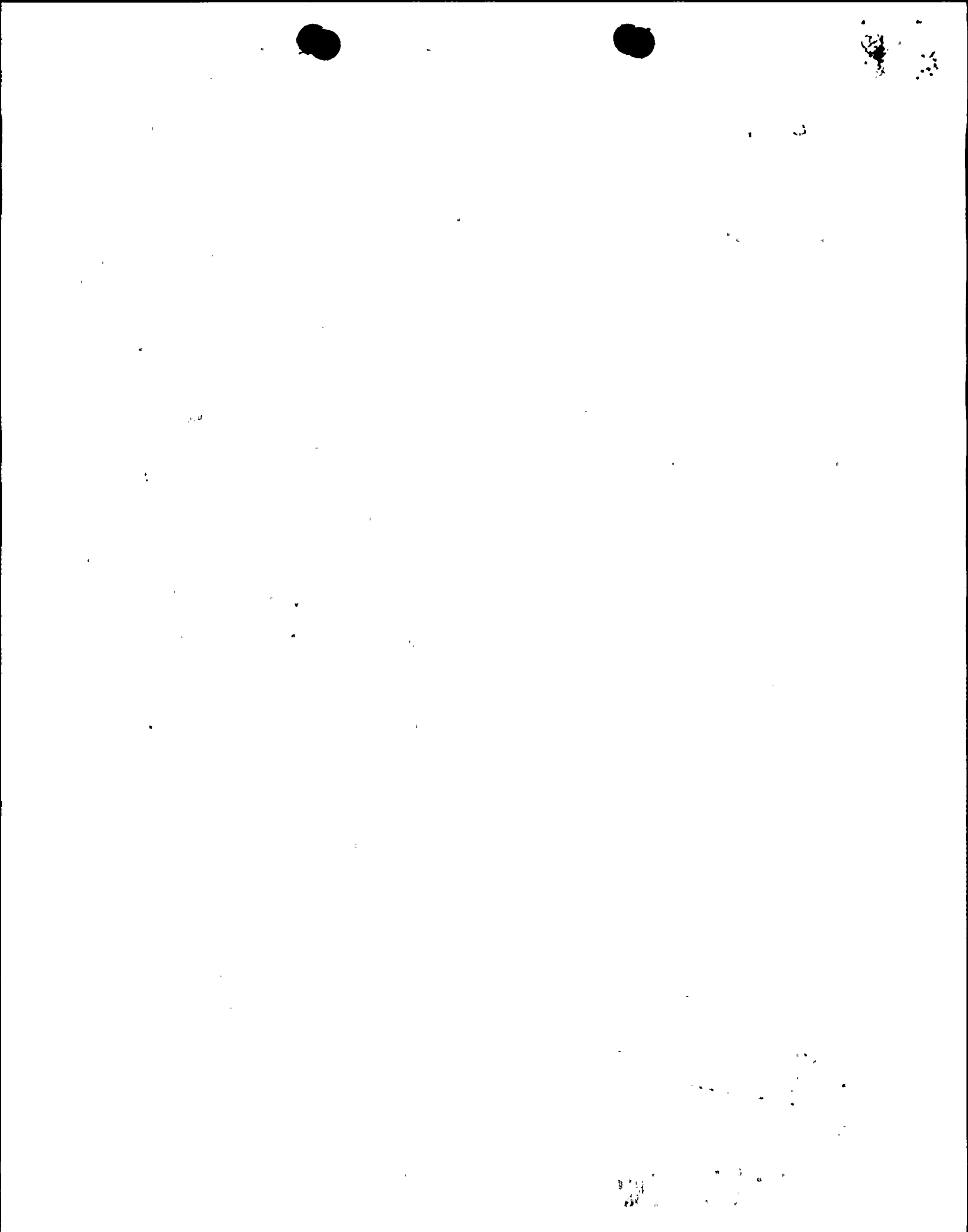
