Dear Ms. Lloyd:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received your letter dated May 22, 2017, in which you requested that the NRC deny the request for the amendment to export license XW012/05 for Perma-Fix Northwest, Inc (Perma-Fix). In your letter, you also recommended that the NRC conduct additional coordination with Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) regarding public noticing by CNSC of Canadian parties named as ultimate consignees listed in XW012/012.

We take note of your request to deny the amendment to the export license. Regarding communications or public noticing of Canadian import/export activities, the NRC has forwarded your letter to our Canadian colleagues, Mr. Michael Kent and Ms. Stephanie MacDonald of CNSC. The NRC shares technical information with its regulatory counterparts and has had a long-standing cooperative relationship with CNSC. In addition, as part of the export application review process, the U.S. Government seeks assurances from the recipient country's government to confirm, among other things, that the end users identified on export license applications are appropriately authorized to receive and possess the commodities proposed for export. For further information on import/export licensing matters regarding Canadian parties, brokers, and/or consignees, we recommend that you contact CNSC.

We appreciate your taking the time to write us and encourage you to continue to be involved in CNSC regulatory activities as a member of the public.
