On May 30, 2017, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* ([82 FR 24457](#)) confirming the effective date of June 7, 2017, for the direct final rule that was published in the *Federal Register* on March 24, 2017 ([82 FR 14987](#)). The direct final rule amended the NRC's spent fuel storage regulations by revising the "List of Approved Spent Fuel Storage Casks" to add the TN Americas, LLC, NUHOMS® Extended Optimized Storage Dry Spent Fuel Storage System as Certificate of Compliance No. 1042.

Public Meeting on Decommissioning Plans for Fort Calhoun Station

On May 31, 2017, staff held a public meeting in Omaha, Nebraska, to discuss and receive comments on the decommissioning plans for the Fort Calhoun Station (FCS). The NRC provided a brief overview of the FCS Post Shutdown Activities Report and the staff's review, discussed the decommissioning transition process, and then accepted public comments and responded to questions. Prior to the public meeting, the staff held a government-to-government (G2G) meeting to discuss topics of interest with State and local officials and representatives from nearby Native American Tribes. A representative from the office of Senator Deb Fischer (R-NE) attended the G2G meeting.
