Enclosed is an application (XSNM3780), dated May 22, 2017, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), from AREVA Inc. The application requests the export of 34,000 kilograms (kg) of low-enriched uranium to be used as reload fuel at the Genkai Nuclear Power Station, Units 3 and 4, and the Sendai Nuclear Power Station, Unit 2, in Japan.

Assurances from Japan that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of an agreement for cooperation, are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.

Please note that the material is of Canadian and Namibian origin, and was enriched in France and Germany. Therefore, it has Canadian and EURATOM obligations.
