1. The purpose of this memorandum is to inform you that three, 100-microcurie IBIS indicators containing byproduct material have been physically transferred from the United States Coast Guard to Heli-Flite Inc - Aris Helicopters of Riverside, CA.

2. Per 10 CFR 31.5(c)(9), the following information is provided:

3. As explained in reference (a), the Coast Guard acknowledges these devices were improperly transferred to Heli-Flite Inc - Aris Helicopters sometime between 1989 and 2017. The devices are physically located at Aris Helicopters' facility in Riverside California and are installed on a HH-52 helicopter, N52NP, owned and operated by Aris Helicopters.
