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

During our meeting on November 15, 1994, with your staff, we stated that we would provide an evaluation of the Class 1E/non-Class 1E interfaces for the equipment within the scope of supply of GE by the end of the first quarter of 1995. This evaluation was to provide a comparison of circuits at Susquehanna SES with the methodology used at Nine Mile Point 2 to close the Class 1E/non-Class 1E interface issue at Nine Mile Point 2. Recently PP&L engineering personnel visited GE in San Jose, CA to audit their files on this issue. During this audit, it was discovered that the resolutions to the Class 1E/non-Class 1E at Nine Mile Point 2 had additional complexities which needed further review by PP&L. Based upon this discovery, the evaluation will take longer than originally anticipated. Therefore, our evaluation will be submitted by August 18, 1995.
