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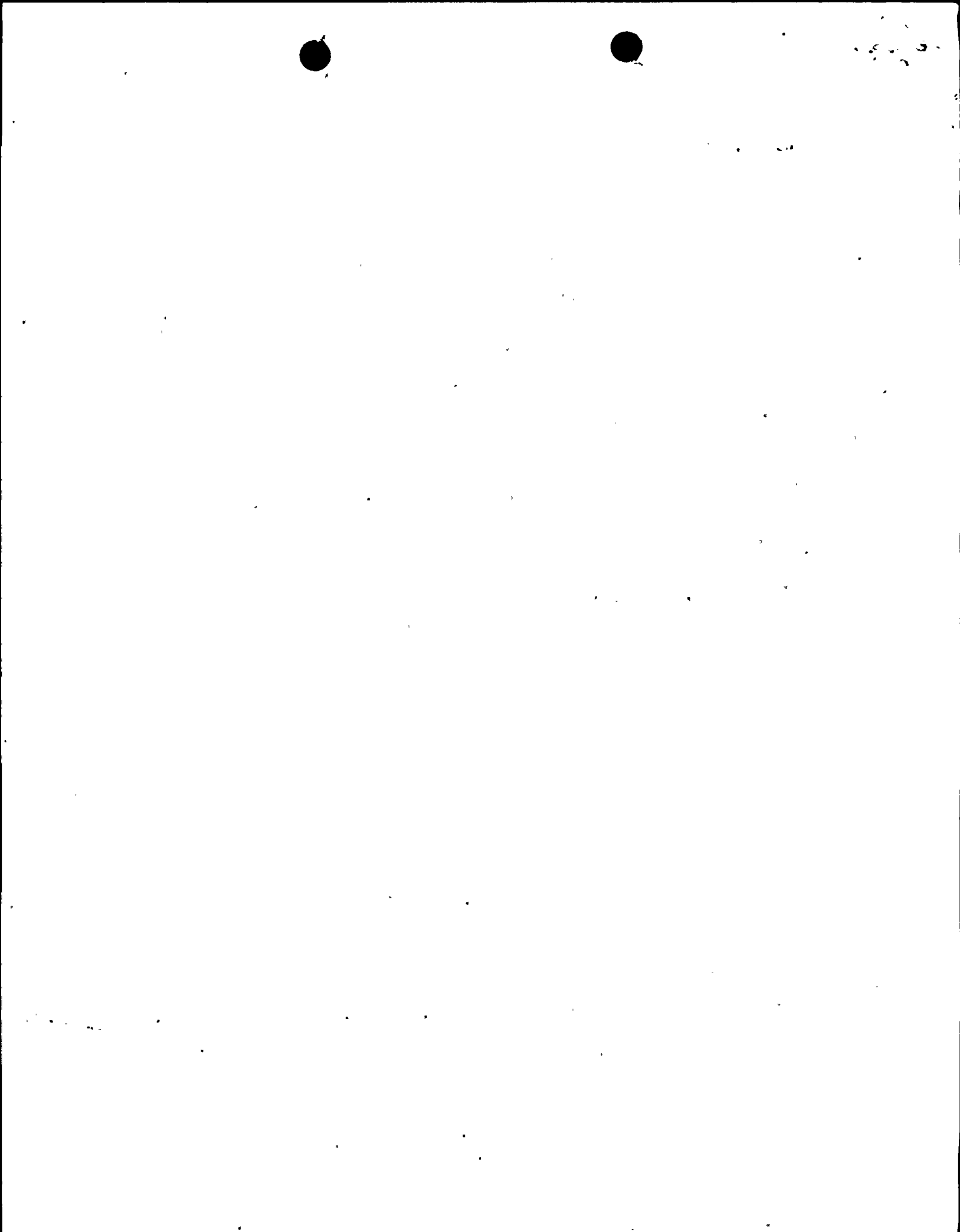


NOTE: This letter supersedes PLA-4984, dated October 23, 1998, in its entirety.
