a copy of all emails from the domain EOP.gov to senior managers encompassed within the required agency system for retaining emails of senior officials at NRC. Frequently this records management policy/system is described by the name Capstone.

If the agency has not yet established NARA-compliant email retention procedures, then I instead request an electronic search of the mailboxes of agency senior managers for all emails that include the EOP.gov phrase in the FROM address.
