SUBJECT: JUNE 15, 2017, MEETING SUMMARY REGARDING HONEYWELL
INTERNATIONAL'S LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION REVIEW
STATUS (COST ACTIVITY CODE L34389)

On June 15, 2017, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and representatives of Honeywell International, Inc. (Honeywell) held a Category 1 meeting to discuss the NRC staff's review status related to Honeywell Metropolis Works' (MTW's) license renewal application (LRA). Honeywell's LRA was submitted by letter dated February 8, 2017 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System [ADAMS] Accession Number ML17048A263).

The June 15, 2017, meeting was divided into two portions. The first portion of the meeting was open to the public, during which the NRC staff provided the general status to date on the review efforts associated with the LRA as submitted by Honeywell. In particular, the NRC staff shared that the letter regarding acceptance review and timely renewal status was transmitted by letter dated May 2, 2017 (ADAMS Accession Number ML17111740), and the notice on the receipt of the LRA, opportunity to request a hearing and to petition for leave to intervene, would be published in the *Federal Register* on June 19, 2017. The second portion of the meeting was closed to the public because specific information on Honeywell's Integrated Safety Analysis (ISA) Summary, which contains security-related information, and other security-related information related to the LRA, was discussed.

The discussions held during this meeting benefited both the NRC staff and Honeywell representatives, as they provided effective and efficient forum of communication on the license renewal review efforts. No staff decision was made during the meeting.
