FOR FOURTH 120-MONTH INSERVICE TESTING INTERVAL (RELIEF REQUEST PR-07)**


By letter dated June 1, 2017 (ADAMS Accession No. ML17153A067), Union Electric Company (Ameren Missouri) requested NRC approval of a relief request, identified as PR-07, for the fourth 10-year inservice testing interval at Callaway. The relief request (now under review by the NRC staff) proposes an alternative to the method for establishment of vibration reference values as specified in ASME OM Code ISTB-3300, for selected "smooth-running pumps."

No specific date or timeframe for NRC approval was requested in the June 1, 2017 submittal letter. However, in order to allow the alternative method to be used for establishing vibration reference values for pump testing that will be performed during upcoming refuel outage RF22, this follow-up letter is submitted to respectfully request that the requested relief be approved by September 28, 2017.

Although this letter does not contain new commitments, Ameren Missouri understands that due to the short duration of the requested licensing activity, the NRC staff may require accelerated response times for submittal of responses to requests for additional information, if any such responses are needed.
