ANNETTE VIETTI-COOK: This is on SECY-17-0067 – Waste Control Specialists LLC (Consolidated Interim Storage Facility). The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order that addresses the joint request of Waste Control Specialists LLC and the NRC Staff to withdraw the *Federal Register* notice of opportunity to request a hearing associated with Waste Control Specialists' application to construct and operate a consolidated interim waste storage facility in Andrews County, Texas, in light of the Staff's suspension of review activities associated with the application.

The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order that grants the request and approves withdrawal of the *Federal Register* notice. The Memorandum and Order also addresses the additional measures jointly requested by the Sierra Club, the Sustainable Energy and Economic Development Coalition, and Beyond Nuclear.
