Gallagher of this office on September 26-27 and October 22-23, 1979 at Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Units 2 and 3, on October 3-4, 1979 at Zion Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2, and on November 7-9, 1979 at Quad-Cities Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2, of activities authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-19, No. DPR-25, No. DPR-29, No. DPR-30, No. DPR-39 and No. DPR-48, and to the discussion of our findings with Messrs. B. Stephenson, N. Kalivianakis, N. Wandke and others of your staff. This also refers to a meeting held at our office on November 13, 1979, and attended by Mr. L. Peoples and others of your staff and Mr. L. Spessard and Mr. E. Gallagher of my staff.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

No items of noncompliance with NRC requirements were identified during the course of this inspection.
