Reference (b) provided Commonwealth Edison Company's (CECo) response to the subject Violation which was transmitted with the Reference (a) letter and Inspection Report. The violation dealt with two workers who had not properly followed the requirements of the governing Radiation Work Permit. As part of the corrective actions cited by CECo, the Nuclear General Employee Training (NGET) Program was to be expanded by December 31, 1991, to address advanced rad worker training. The expanded NGET Program was to be based on a pilot program at CECo's Braidwood Station. As a result of the pilot program, lesson plan modification and additional resources were necessary for successful implementation. The proposed method for handling advanced rad worker training was revised and has been scheduled for implementation at Dresden Station during 1992.

The radiation protection (RP) portion of Level-B NGET is being expanded to include additional hours of RP specific training. The additional training will include modules on dosimetry, instrumentation and RP theory. The revised Level-B NGET should be in place in June 1992.
