In the referenced letter, Commonwealth Edison (CECo) proposed to
amend several instrumentation tables within Appendix A, Technical
Specifications to Facility Operating Licenses DPR-19 and DPR-25. The proposed
changes incorporated enhancements from the BWR Standard Technical
Specifications. Other clarifications to the Rod Block Monitor and APRM Rod
Block operability requirements were included in the proposed amendment.
